


#### Response

- PHEIC Declaration: 22<sup>nd</sup>
  Dec 2023
- nOPV2 NID, targeting
  3,003,656 under-5yrs
  - Started 27<sup>th</sup> Feb
    2024.
- Polio surveillance intensification

- 16 nt difference
- ❖ Date onset 7/11/23

- 3 Positive Healthy Children

  - o RSS-WEQ-YAM-23-013-CC18, 18 NT diff, cVDPV2.




#### 3. RSS-UNL-LPY-23-013

- VDPV2
- Child tracing ongoing in Ghambela, Ethiopia

#### 2. RSS-CEQ-JUB-23-014

- 17 nt difference
- Date of onset 4/11/23
- cVDPV2
- DCI found the child in Awerial, Lakes State

### **Surveillance Response**



- □ Detailed Case investigation for all PV2 positives is planned
- ☐ Active Surveillance Intensification
  - 1. Re-prioritizatio Surveillance of active surveillance sites
  - 2. Increase the frequency of active surveillance visit and sensitization
  - 3. Refresher training and sensitization of the Polio Surveillance workforce
  - 4. Sensitize MoH, field officers and partners on Polio surveillance during the SIAs trainings
  - 5. Expand electronic Surveillance (Increased numbers and frequency of ISS/e-Surv)


#### ☐ Environmental Surveillance

- 1) Increase the frequency of ES sampling from monthly to twice/Month
- 2) Introduce composite sampling to increase sensitivity of ES (as a strategy to raise the EV isolation rates above 50%.
- 3) Add one ES site outside of Juba (Malakal County, U/Nile)

## Your Support is needed



- □ Be the first to report any child with Acute Flaccid Paralysis
  □ Provide assets (human, mobility and presence) to support H2H vaccination teams
  □ Keeping the one week of the campaign, free of community demobilising interventions
- □Post Campaign,
  - 1. Ask to have a vaccination team coming with you to the food distribution points
  - 2. Check the finger marks and ensure that all children under 5 years have indellible ink marks
  - 3. Refer all children with unmarked finger markers to the vaccination team for OPV administration
- □This is the first of the two planned response vaccination campaigns. The next one is planned for the 2nd week of April. Dates TBC by MOH
