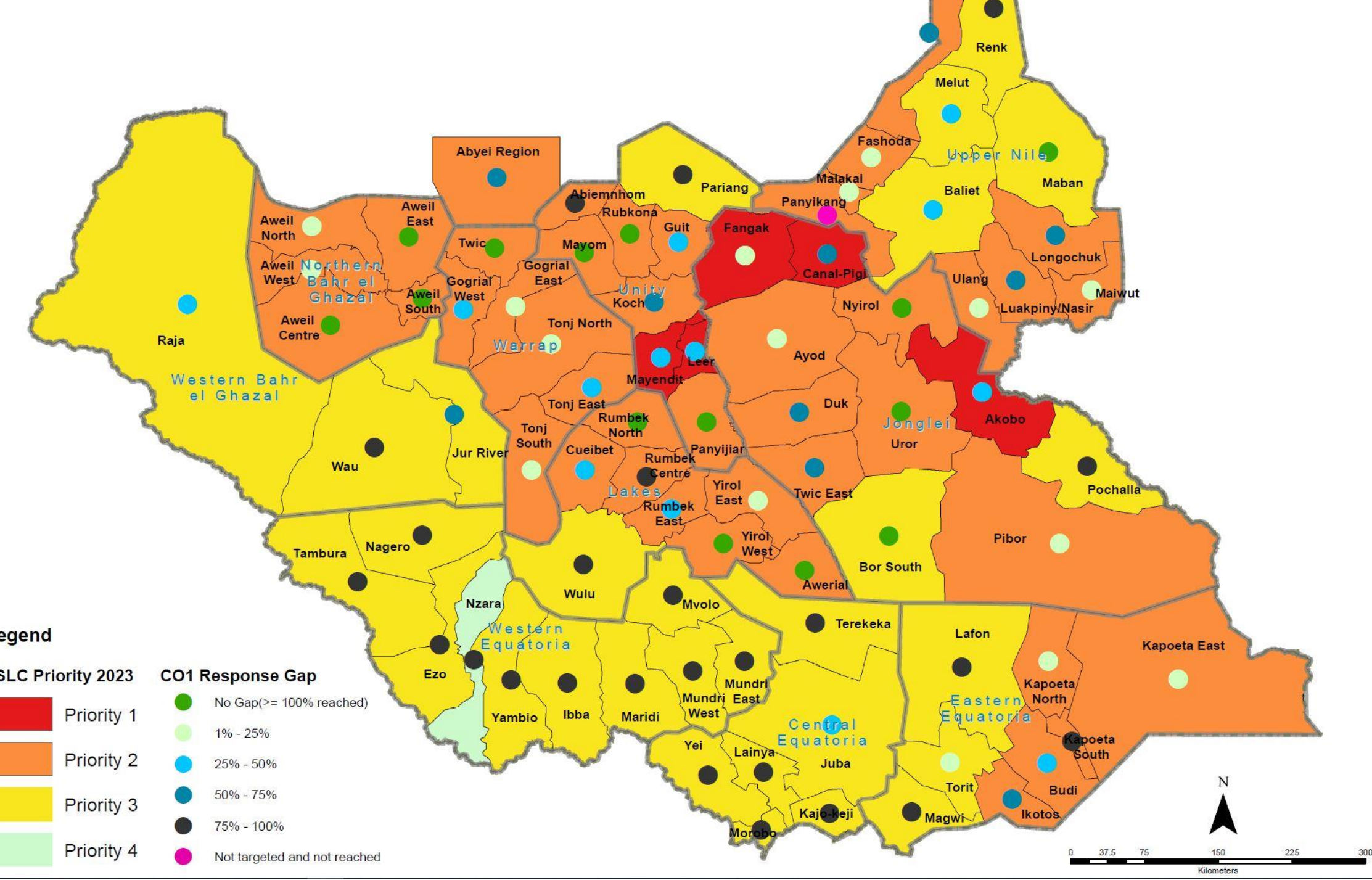


### FSLC HRP 2023 prioritization and food assistance (CO1) gaps as of December 2023

### CONTEXT UPDATE

IPC Classification according to the September/October IPC analysis, 5.83 million people (this figure excludes Abyei), are expected to face Crisis (IPC Phase 3) or worse acute food insecurity in the September to November 2023 period (46% of the population), with 35,403 people likely to be in Catastrophe (IPC Phase 5) acute food insecurity in Duk, Nyirol, Rubkona, and amongst the returnees from Sudan. Seasonal improvements in the food security situation, mainly due to the harvest period, are likely to be relatively short lived. In addition, the continued inflow of returnees and refugees from Sudan will continue to place pressure on host community food stocks, and in the months, movement is likely to increase as fighting spreads in Darfur and towards Kosti, and as the dry season sets in, improving movement options.
