Overview

Type of Intervention/Project: (in-kind food, cash vouchers.)

Duration of the project: Church of Sweden project (6 months), WFP project (2 months, with 5 month extension being agreed)

Geographical Coverage/location: (Borno, Konduga)

<u>Konduga</u>

Christian Aid has finished registration of IDPs IDP camps and host communities of Mashimari A and B, Jakana, Jakana Mallumbi and Auno North and South in Kondoga LGA, Borno State. Cash distributions will commence shortly. The first distribution will be made up of 17,000 per household, with amounts being determined by number of family members rather than an overall household value being considered for future distributions. Distributions are planned for a period of 3 months. NFI distributions and WASH interventions are also planned.

Konduga and Maiduguri

Christian Aid began registration and distribution of food to IDPs in registered IDP camps, host communities of EYN Jerusalem IDP camp, Maiduguri Metropolitan Council, Malakyari, Tampsungamdu, Mafa and Auno, Kondoga LGA, Borno State.

Activities and Results Achieved

Konduga

The Key activities carried out so far include

- Visits to IDP camps to interact and collect relevant information on camp situations, population estimates as well get buy in and support of IDPs for the food distribution project
- Registration of IDPs
- Rapid Market assessment in host communities for interventions
- Meetings, interactions and planning meeting with Mobile money agents carrying out Cash voucher activity as well as food vendors.

IDP Registration:

- Total Households registered: 1,450
- Total Beneficiary Population: 10,050

Konduga and Maiduguri

The Key activities in the period under review were

- Scoping visits to IDP camps to interact and collect relevant information on camp situations, population estimates as well get buy in and support of IDPs for the food distribution project
- Registration of IDPs using SCOPE software
- Food distribution to registered communities

In all communities visited, the CA team was well received by the IDP community members, who committed to ensuring orderliness, security and support in the registration and distribution of food.

- In-kind assistance and Food distribution to IDPs in EYN Jerusalem Camp, Malakyari host community, DCC Shuwari IDP camp.

Maiduguri, Dikwa & Monguno

Christian Aid is finalizing this week an agreement with WFP for a 5-month extension of our work in Maiduguri locations. We will also plan to start distributions to a caseload of approximately 60,000 in Dikwa and 35,000 in Monguno starting in February.
