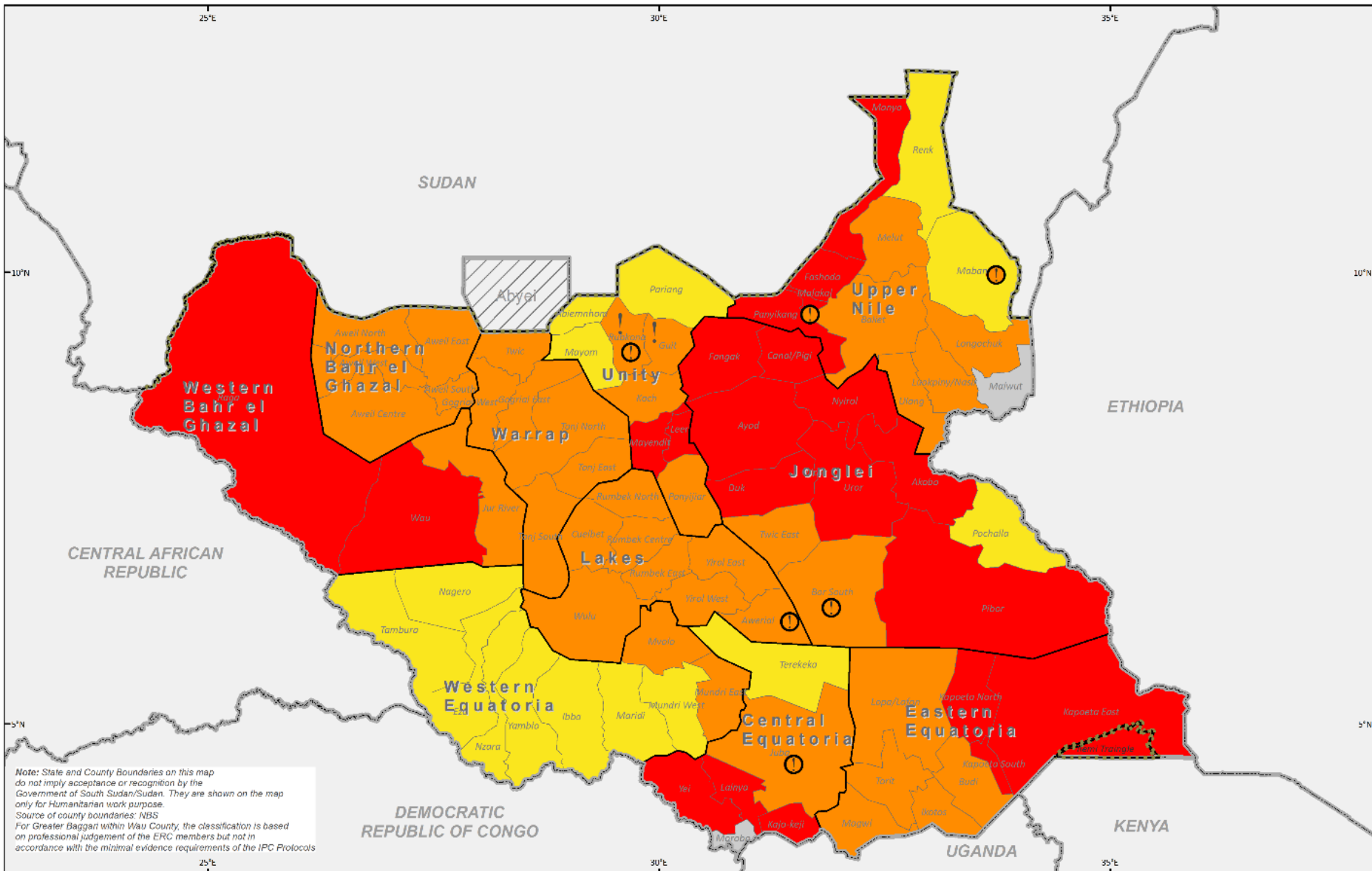

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# Emergency support: 2018 ELRP



**730 000 households**  
(about 4.3 million people)

**Main season: 400 000 households**  
(support to crop, vegetable and fish production)

**Dry season: 155 000 households**  
(support to vegetable and fish production)



**8.7 million livestock** to be vaccinated and treated



**175 000 households** to be reached through rapid response missions

### Greater Bahr el Ghazal



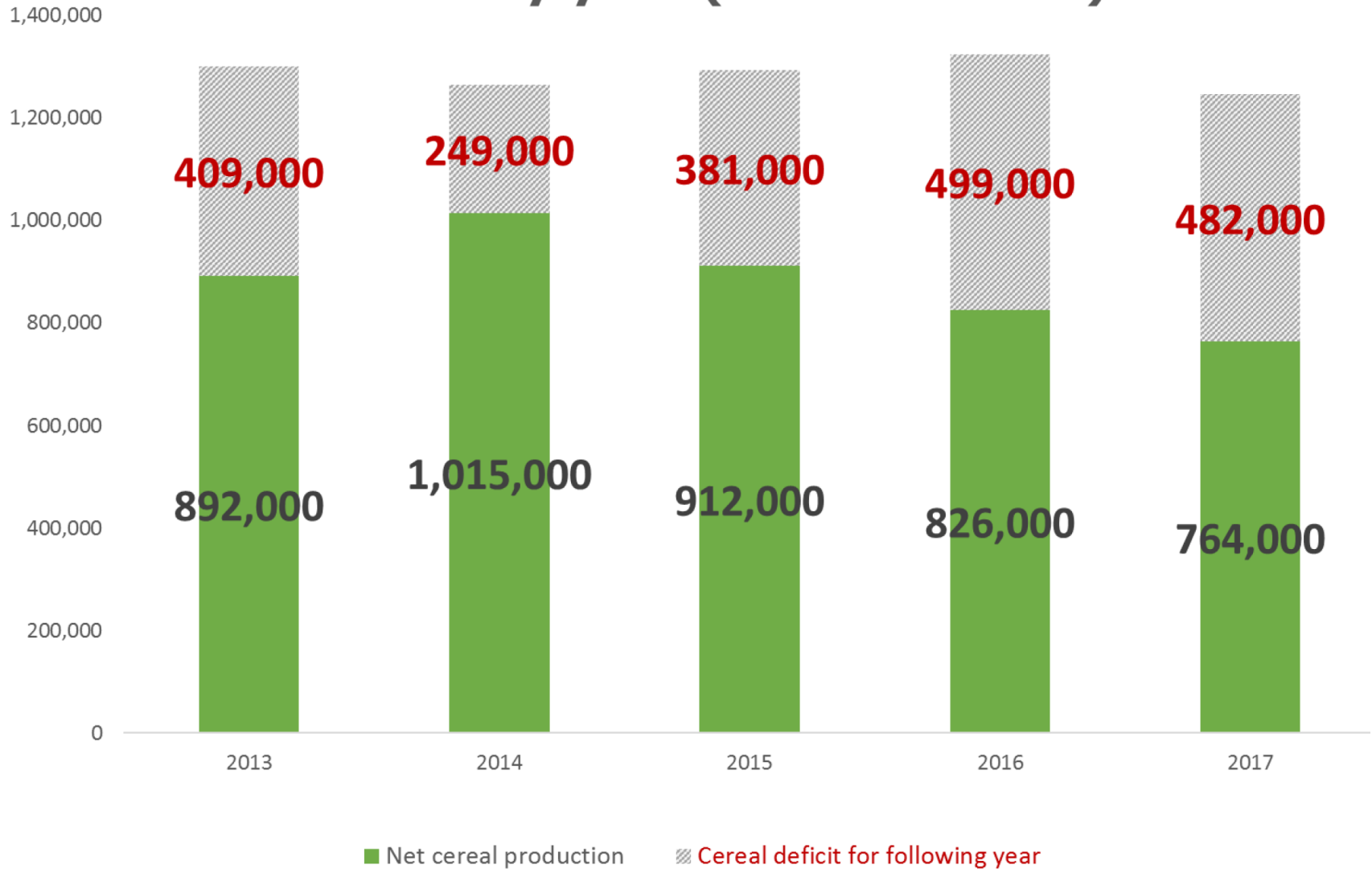

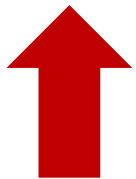
