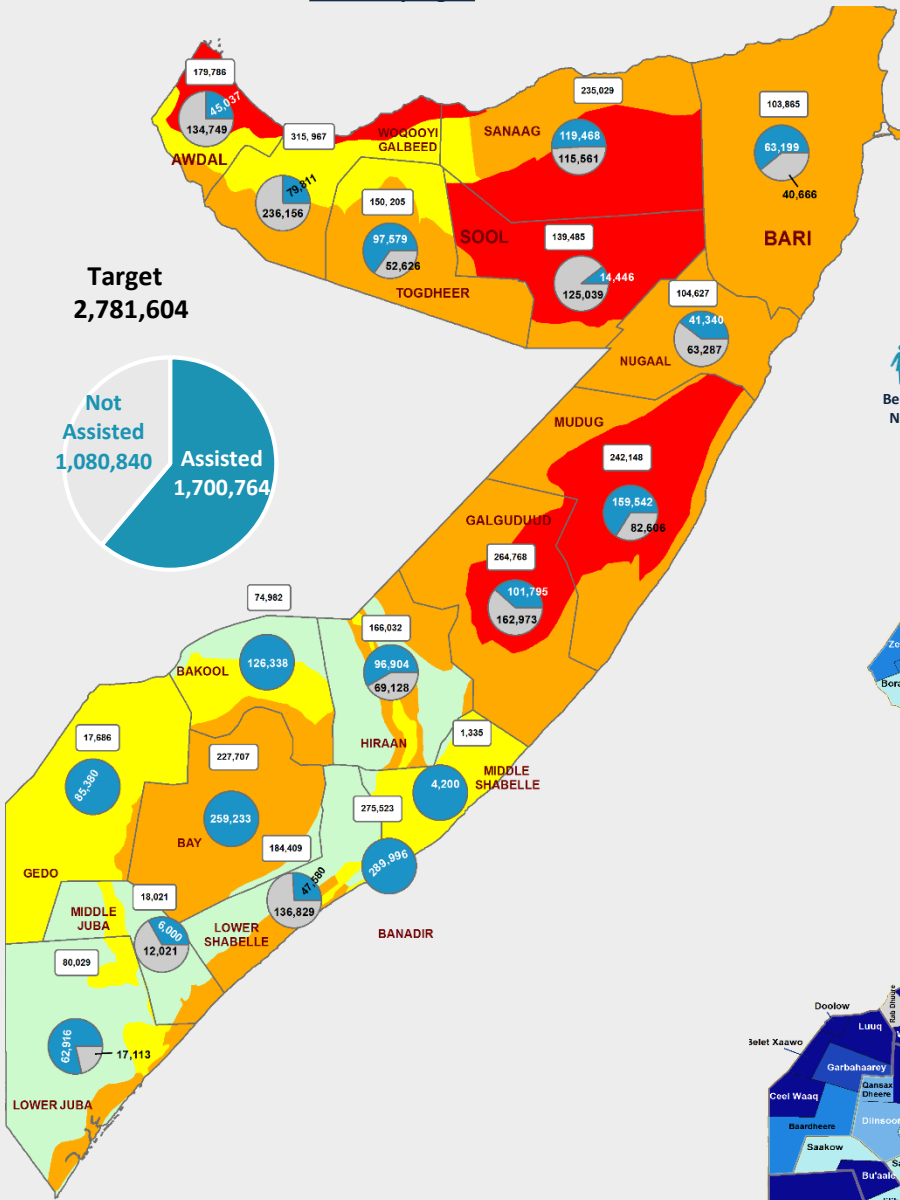

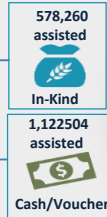

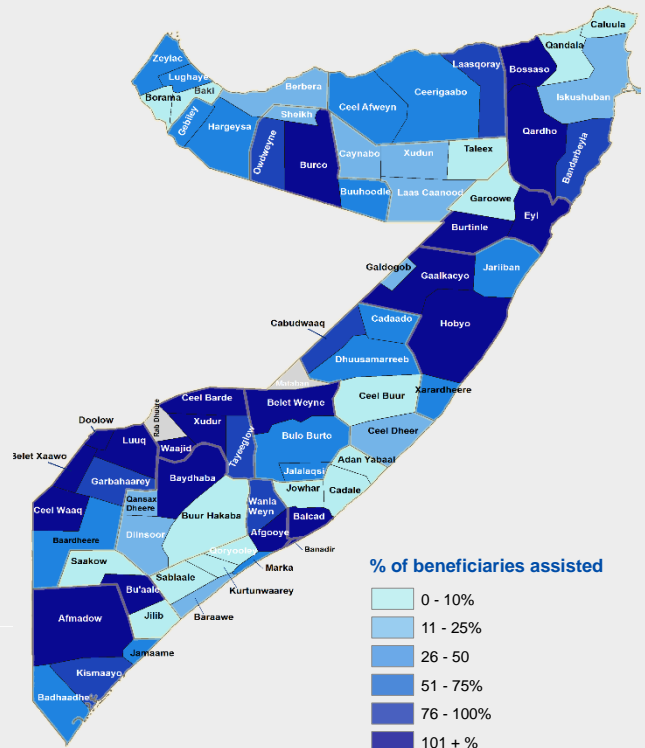

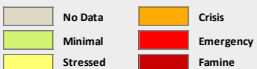

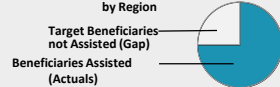
Percentage of Targeted Beneficiaries Assisted per District

Strategic Objective 1 Update

The overall response has reduced by about **250,000** beneficiaries (13%) as compared to last month. The continuous downward trend of IASN assistance is a concern for the cluster particularly in Woqooyi Galbeed, Sool, Sanaag, Mudug and Galguduud regions which are classified as Emergency (Phase 4) on the IPC, FSNAU map.

In these regions, less than **50%** beneficiaries received assistance compared to target.

The bulk of the assistance was provided by three key partners who jointly assisted 69% of the beneficiaries in March i.e. WFP (53%), FAO (9%) and SCI (7%).

The remaining 31% of the total beneficiaries were assisted by 16 organizations collectively.
