The meeting was attended by representatives of **9 organizations** active in the Vinnytska oblast. We thank all our partners for their presence and participation in the voting.

The Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster (FSLC) presented the **general overview** on brief history, functions and objectives of the cluster, following the cluster updates in Vinnytska oblast. [The FSLC Interactive Dashboard](#) was presented on the meeting, showcasing how partners can access all the information about the FSLC partners' response in a region, as well as pointing the importance of the reporting, which allows to see clearer picture of the response.

The FSLC presented **the Coordination Focal Point (CFP)** Terms of Reference (ToR), which were followed by presentations of the following nominees for CFP in Vinnytska Oblast:

- **Caritas-SPES Vinnytsia**
- **Spilna Sprava**

Each nominee was given time to present their activities and motivations for wanting to coordinate humanitarian work on food security and livelihoods in their area.

The elections were held in a closed format where partners wrote the name of the partner they prefer to lead Vinnytsia sub-national cluster. The voting went in two rounds, as there was a tie (3-3, 2 organizations abstained) between Caritas-SPES and Spilna Sprava after the first round. Caritas-SPES received a higher number of votes (3 out of 7, 2 organizations abstained) on the second round of voting. **Evhen Markevych from Caritas-SPES Vinnytsia takes a lead in the coordination in the Oblast.** Evhen will present the FSLC at the general coordination meeting (GCM) and other platforms that required inter cluster coordination.

The agenda and date of the first FSLC Vinnytsia sub-cluster coordination meeting will be agreed later soon.
