The meeting was attended by 67 representatives of 46 organizations active in Zaporizka oblast including local authorities. We thank all our partners for their presence and participation in the voting. The Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster (FSLC) presented an overview of the partners' response in Zaporizska for June, allowing partners to understand how Cluster uses the information they provide. In detail, 16 partner organizations supported 360,579 people in the oblast during the last month (including 76,678 of Rapid Response Ration – Bread), while the number of people in need is estimated as of 255,926. Cluster used the opportunity to highlight the importance of reporting to the Cluster via the ActivityInfo platform.

During the overview of the FSLC Interactive Dashboard, which was presented in detail to all participants, Cluster addressed the respective questions by the audience. Partners suggested that having the breakdown by hromadas level would be a highly helpful tool. Participants have also underlined the necessity of a regular monthly and contingency planning of humanitarian aid distribution.

The FSLC presented an overview of subnational coordination Terms of Reference (ToR), and response update. Organizations that nominated themselves for the role of coordinator at the subnational level in Zaporizska oblast:

- CF "Caritas Zaporizhzhia"
- CF "Office of Perspective Development"
- "Relief Coordination Center" (RCC)

Each nominee was given time to present their activities and motivations to become a Coordinator Focal Point on Zaporizska Oblast. Other participants had an opportunity to address questions to the nominees.

The elections were held in a closed format where partners wrote the name of the partner, they prefer to lead Zaporizska subnational cluster. Present officials from Local authorities served as observers during the elections. As a result of the voting, "Relief Coordination Center" received the highest number of votes (i.e., 26 out of 43). Viktoriia Davydova from RCC will lead the coordination in the oblast. Viktoriia will present the
