The Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster (FSLC)

engages with hundreds of implementing partners, advocating for improved coordination, information flow and matches requests from Oblasts for the most vulnerable population groups affected by the ongoing conflict in Ukraine.

The four guiding outcomes of the FSLC are:

- 1 strengthening food security information for decision making;
- 2 proactively steering food security response coordination;
- 3 improving monitoring and evaluation systems and accountability systems to improve program quality;
- 4 scaling up advocacy, communication, and resource mobilization.

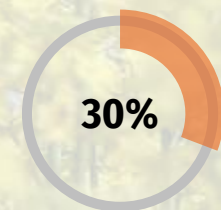

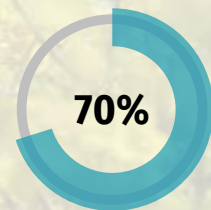

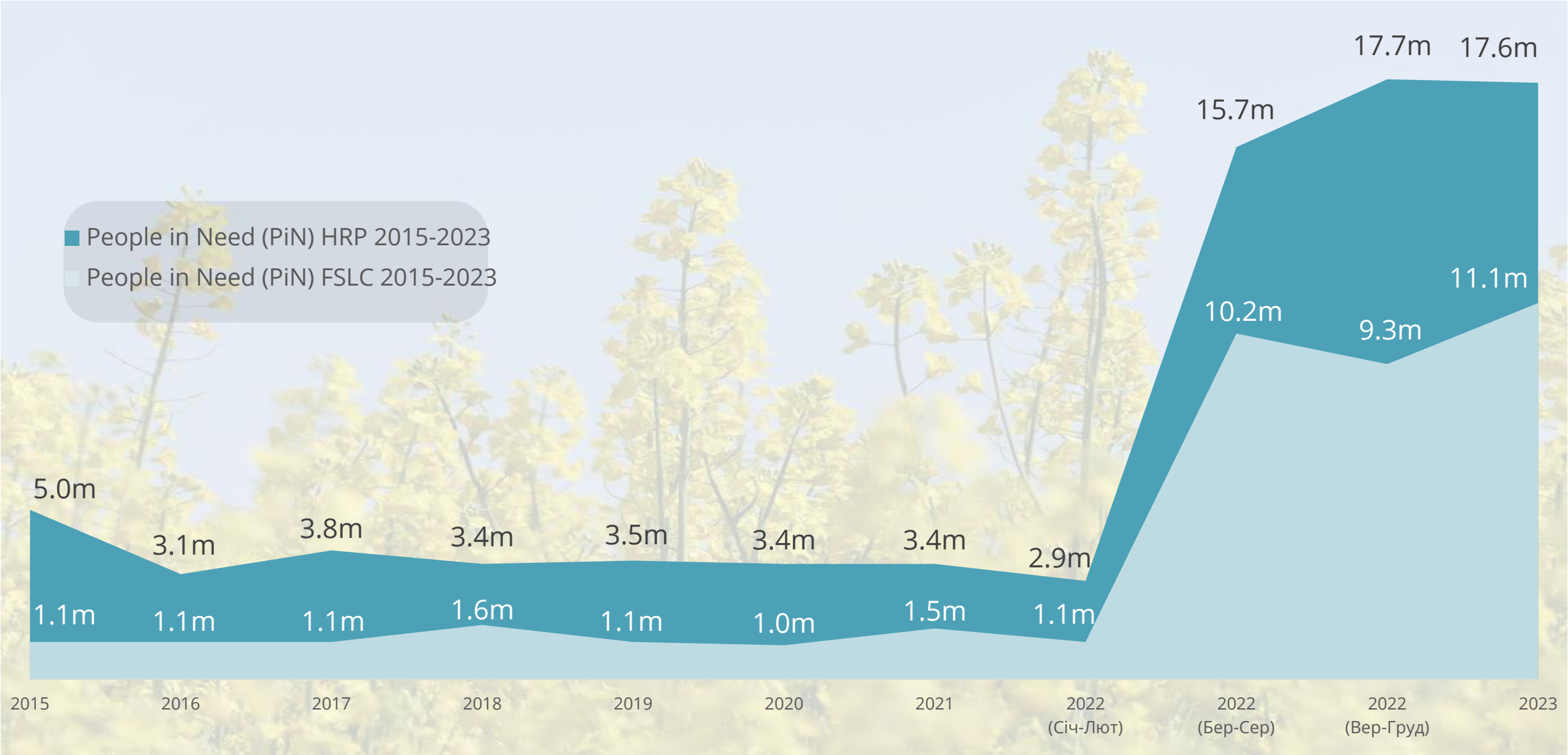

Food Security and Livelihoods Situation in Ukraine 2023

Food Security and Livelihood needs have increased exponentially because of the full-scale illegal invasion of Ukraine by the Russian Federation. While the war shows no signs of abating, humanitarian gains made in Ukraine have been eroded because of the escalation of the war, which has driven millions of people from eastern Ukraine and disrupted agricultural production.

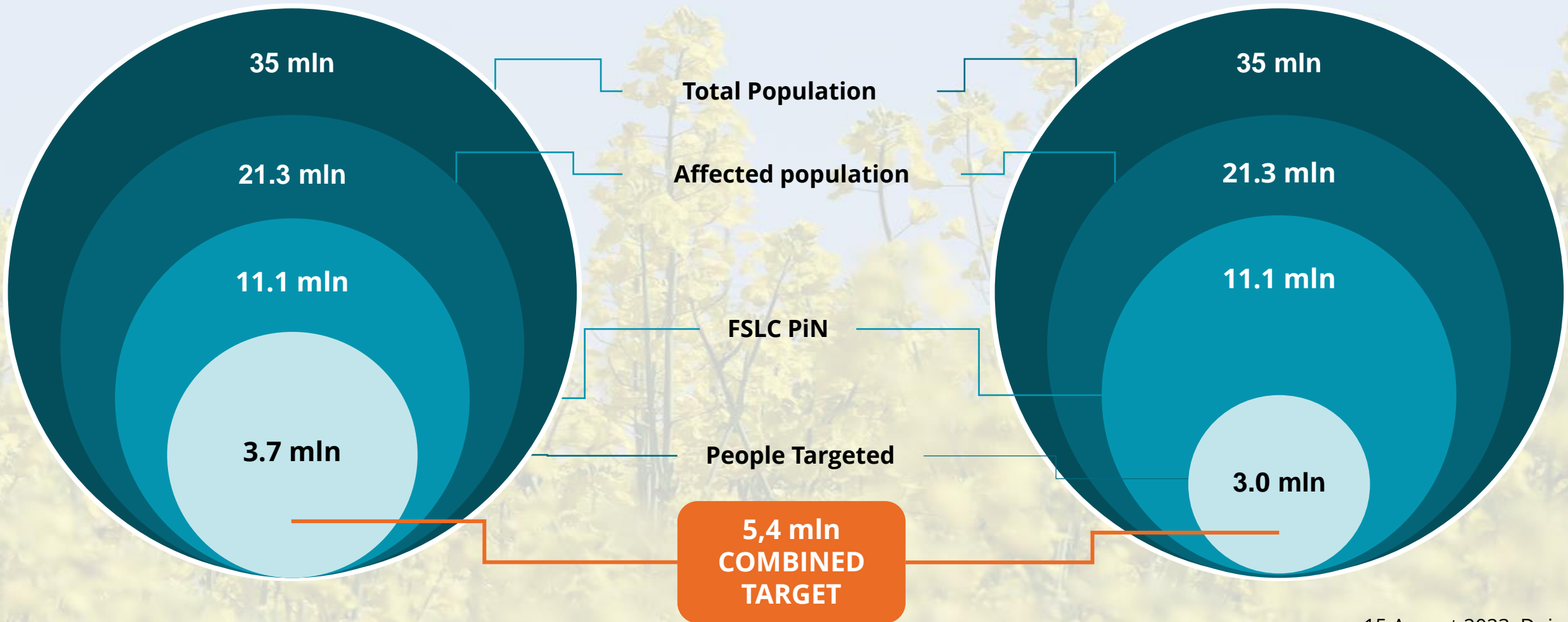

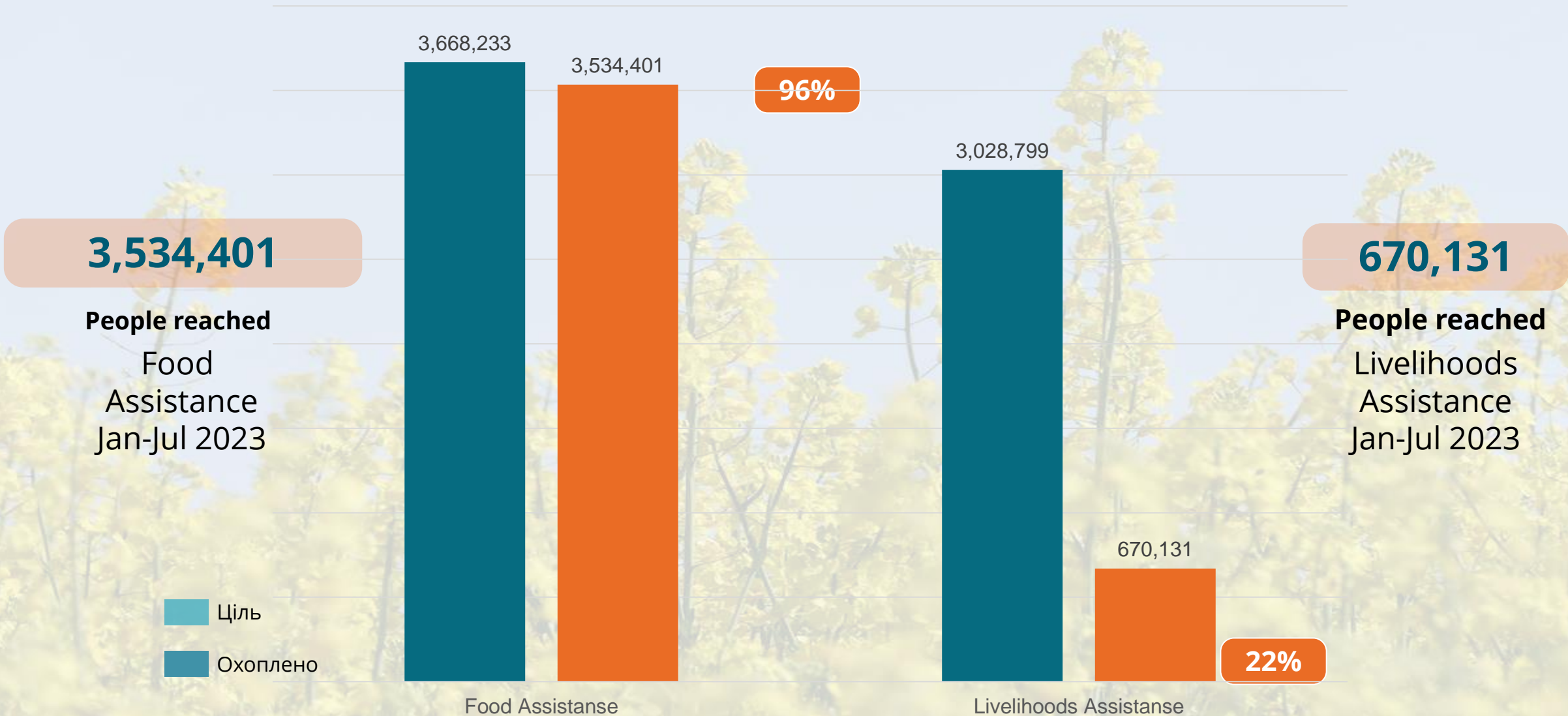



July 2023 CO1 - Food Assistance

In July 2023, FSL Clusters partners provided food assistance to 3,081,655 individuals, representing an impressive 84% of the monthly target. Among these beneficiaries, 62% were recipients of general food distributions, 18% received hot meals, and 20% received rapid response rations. These rations were comprehensive, encompassing 5-day ready-to-eat provisions or bread.

In some raions, the target was achieved in full. Khersonska, Zaporizka, and Donetsk oblasts are fully covered. Odessa, Dnipropetrovska, Kharkivska, Sumska, Poltavska, Chernihivska, Vinnytska, Ivano-Frankivska and Volynska oblasts are partially covered. This achievement is primarily attributed to the non-displaced local population rather than internally displaced persons (IDPs).

32 reporting partners contributed to the response objective: WFP, WCK, SPIR, GEM, U-Saved, AOS, URCS, Caritas UA, AAH, HELP, Posmishka, PHK, GCS, LH, ERC, ASB, Girls, PIN, NW, ACTED, CORE, Poruch, FFKR, CNG, PIN SK, NRC, PWJ, BiY, SI, ForestCom, FZ, TBP UA.

The Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster (FSLC) was established in December 2014 and is led by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and the World Food Programme (WFP). The FSLC coordinates the food security and livelihoods response for more than 500 partners since Russia's full-scale invasion on 24 February 2022.

Response Under HRP 2023 More than 10 million people received food assistance in 2022. Humanitarian needs in areas where ongoing hostilities continue to escalate are increasing. Food insecurity is driven by the war, loss of livelihood opportunities, poverty levels, lack of access to food, and displacement. The number of people in need of food assistance is defined as those who are severely and moderately food insecure.
