FSS GENERAL UPDATES

FSS Field Visit

FSS jointly with FSS partners conducted a site visit on 13 September 2023, the purpose of the FSS partners site visit is to showcase and learn from FSS partner organizations about home gardening related activities. Total 19 participants from 14 organizations were join in the field visit and visited 4 (BRAC, CWW, Mukti, Prottyashi) implementing agencies site (Camp 2W Camp 4, Camp 4 extension, and Camp 15). Based on the site visit FSS prepared a site visit report and published on gFSC website. Website link Here.

FAO beneficiaries request

As per requested by the FAO, FSS shared a common email to FSS partners colleagues to collect those beneficiaries list those are or will not getting homestead gardening support by their organizations for distributing vegetable seeds, Micro gardening tools and Homestead-gardening training in the camp. **Total 21000+** beneficiaries' details were collected from 11 different partners organizations. FAO will communicate with the respective organization and will share the selection process and next course of action. FAO already circulate an express of interest (EOI) for selecting an organization to support FAO for selecting beneficiaries and to also support to provide mentioned items to the respective beneficiaries.

Partners Input | Homestead Garden Research

Firstly, FSS thanks to those partners colleagues for providing their homestead gardening information to FSS. FSS still waiting to response from few organizations whose did not provide their information yet to FSS. During the FSS coordination meeting, FSS requested those partners to share their information by COB 19 October 2023.

The scope of the research is planned to include.

- 1. Some initial desk-based research into project documents from key project implementers and to include a range of International Agencies, INGOs and NGOs (we are dependent of members of the sector being willing to share reports and budgets). We hope this will yield
 - The size of projects and costs per head
 - Whether gardens used chemical or organic inputs
 - Type of gardens implemented, home, school, community, rooftop etc
 - National or heritage seeds, advice given on seed saving
 - Length, scope and content of training offered (regenerative, permaculture, climate resilient etc), designed and delivered by resident, national or international personnel)
 - Training approaches used, and type and availability of training material
 - Follow up support offered
 - Records kept of yields Kcas/month??
 - Records kept of foods produced and consumed
 - Comparisons of costs and approaches with range of foods produced and consumed and amounts of water used.

Under the emergency recovery project, to response the cyclone MOCHA effected population, Helvetas distributed agriculture kits to the 3335 beneficiaries in both Rohnigya and host community. The project will be end by this month.
