COUNTRY RESPONSE UPDATE

In May 2021, FSL cluster partners assisted 2.5 million people with emergency food assistance. 74% of beneficiaries received in-kind, 22% received cash and vouchers and 4% received hybrid support.

Overall, from January to May 2021, FSL cluster partners assisted over 3.1 million unique beneficiaries with emergency food assistance.

In total, 49 partners carried out response in providing food assistance under CO1.

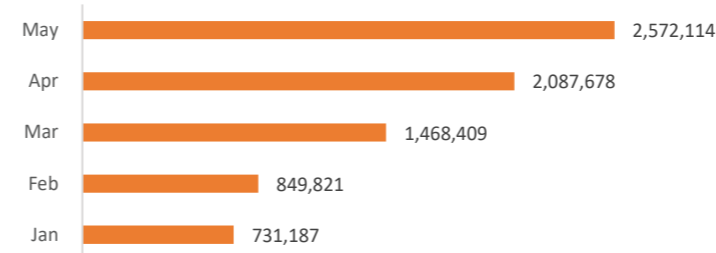

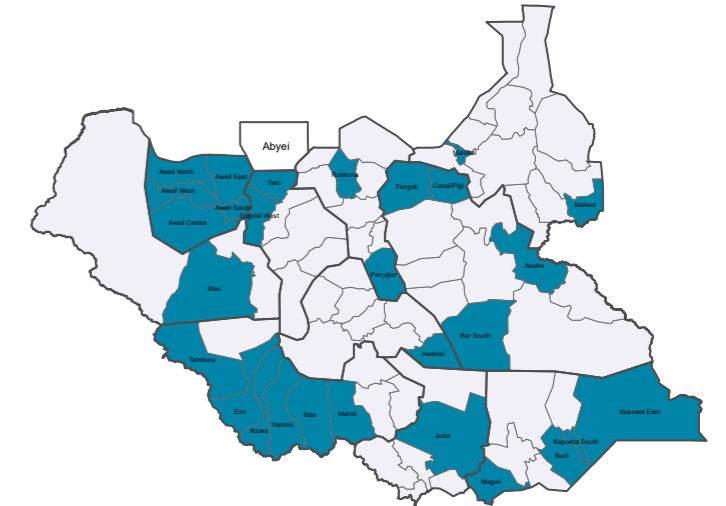

RESPONSE BY MONTH (People reached)

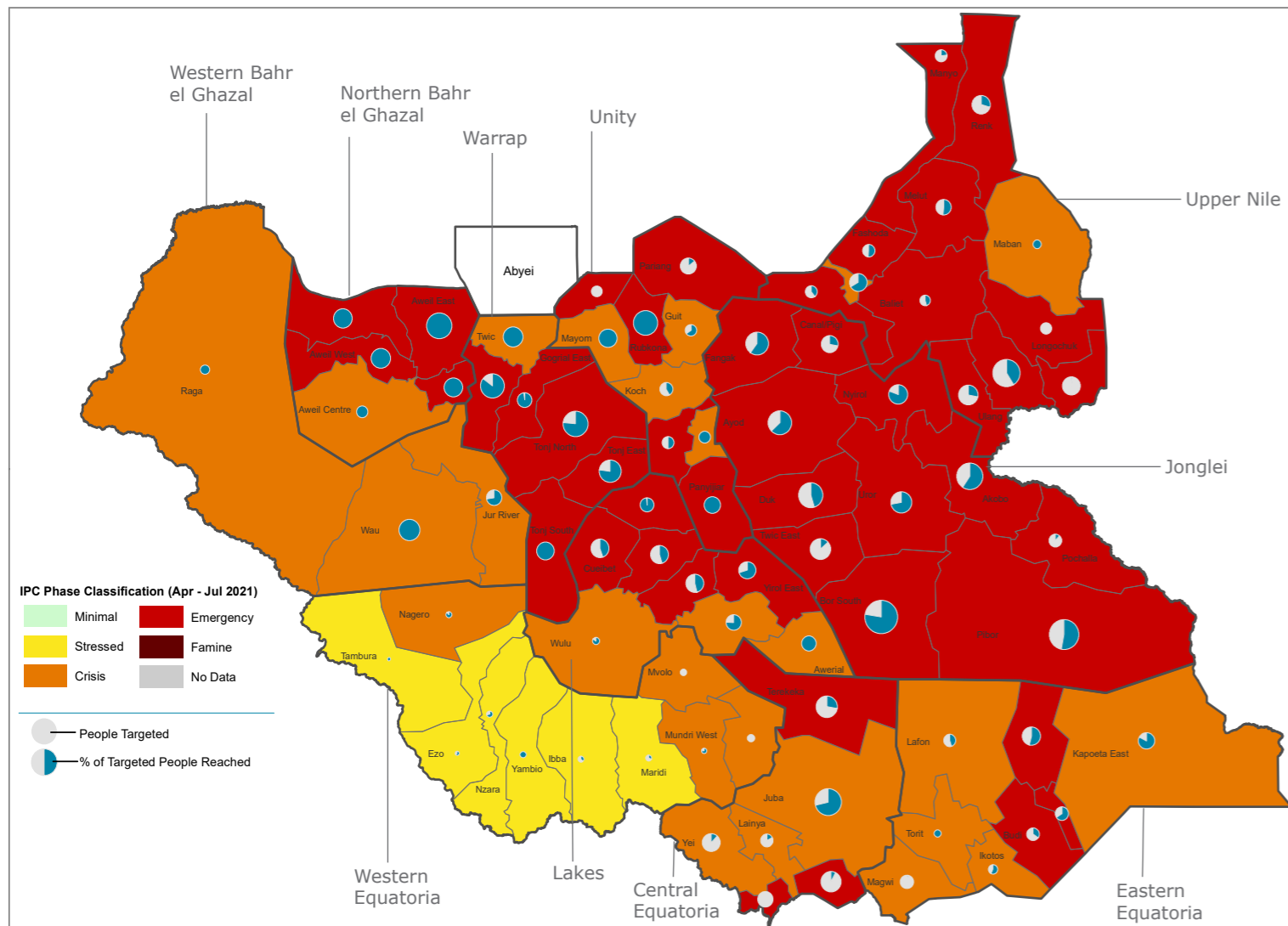


CASH AND VOUCHER

Since January 2021, 570,568 unique beneficiaries have been reached with cash/voucher to support food assistance in 28 counties by 24 partners.

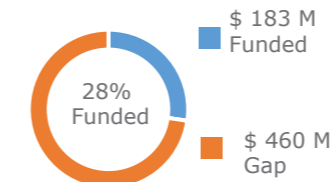


PEOPLE REACHED BY FOOD ASSISTANCE (CLUSTER OBJECTIVE 1)

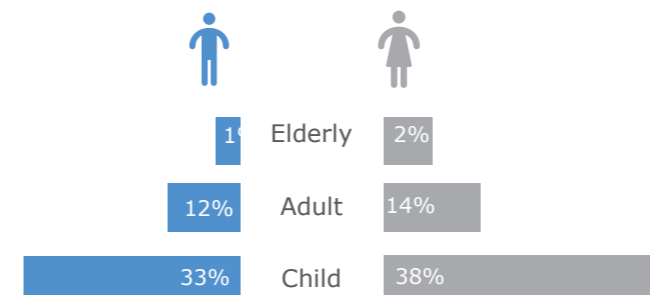

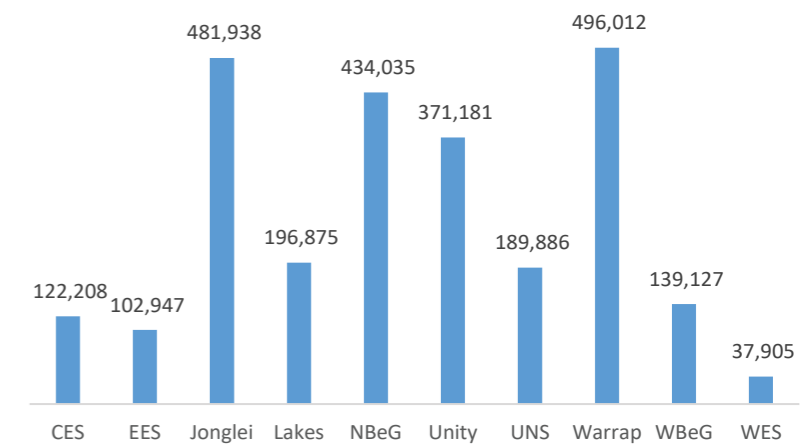
