1. **Updates on the CWG.** The CWG welcomed the new Cash Working Group coordinator – Mr. Moses Kondowe who will be based at the FSL cluster offices in WFP compound
2. **CWG's Priorities for the coming months**
  - i. Support the 2018 HRP process. Incorporate CTP in the HRP and support individual clusters in the process
  - ii. Undertake a feasibility study including risk overview. Collect all available information and identify gaps.
  - iii. Guidelines and tools - developing common approaches and tools. This will include the MEB and transfer value tools that can be used across sectors and easily adapted to specific contexts.
  - iv. Document and share lessons learned and experience exchange among partners, e.g. delivery mechanism.

**Action point:** *Moses to carry out inventory exercise to establish the available tools and guidelines from members and harmonize them.*

- b. Developing an inter cluster information system.
  - i. Expand on the existing dashboard to include all sectors.
  - ii. Market assessment mapping (who is doing what and when)
  - iii. Mapping of organisations' use of MPC and ensure post distribution monitoring analysis (this can help to further argue for MPC – and specially to show case the use for different sectors).
  - iv. Coordinate joint assessments
