Overview of Emergency Responses (August) and Hawiga and Anbar Operations

- FSC coordinator highlighted the areas where the magnitude has been, was the greatest effort has been in Ninawa (Mosul and Telefar). Highlights provided on key points for operational updates for Anbar, Hawiga. For Anbar the coordination structure is yet to be finalized. The working estimate is 85,000 people, and the focal point in Anbar noted that out of camp IDP support needs to be clarified. For Hawija, the working estimate is some 85,000 affected (including Shirqat), a draft plan has been developed including assistance for 60,000 (one round of IRR and two rounds of FRR through WFP)
- For Sulaimaniyah On-going assistance to IDPs and refugees Coordination between WFP and MoMD, the families that did not receive WFP assistance will be covered by MoMD. Highlighted as great practice.
- For Dohuk there is been a multi agency assessment that was conducted (Sinjar Food Security Report) the highlighted recommendation that livelihoods responses need to be advanced and promoted. - Human Appeal distributes 700-900 FFRs daily in west Mosul, and they will start next week distributing FFRs for 10,000 HHs.

Action Point

- The Mosul operation will be added as a separate agenda item for the next FSC meeting.

Humanitarian Need Overview

- Calendar: 20 September, OCHA HNO workshop for clusters. 8 October FSC partner workshop to determine 2018 objectives and targets.
- Currently the FSC is working on the HNO and will need to determine our most vulnerable caseloads based on a set of indicators, a set of several indicators have been selected namely: CSI (livelihoods), Expenditures, and Source of Food.

- OCHA will do OPS training in Erbil for all partners, the FSC will communicate details soon.
