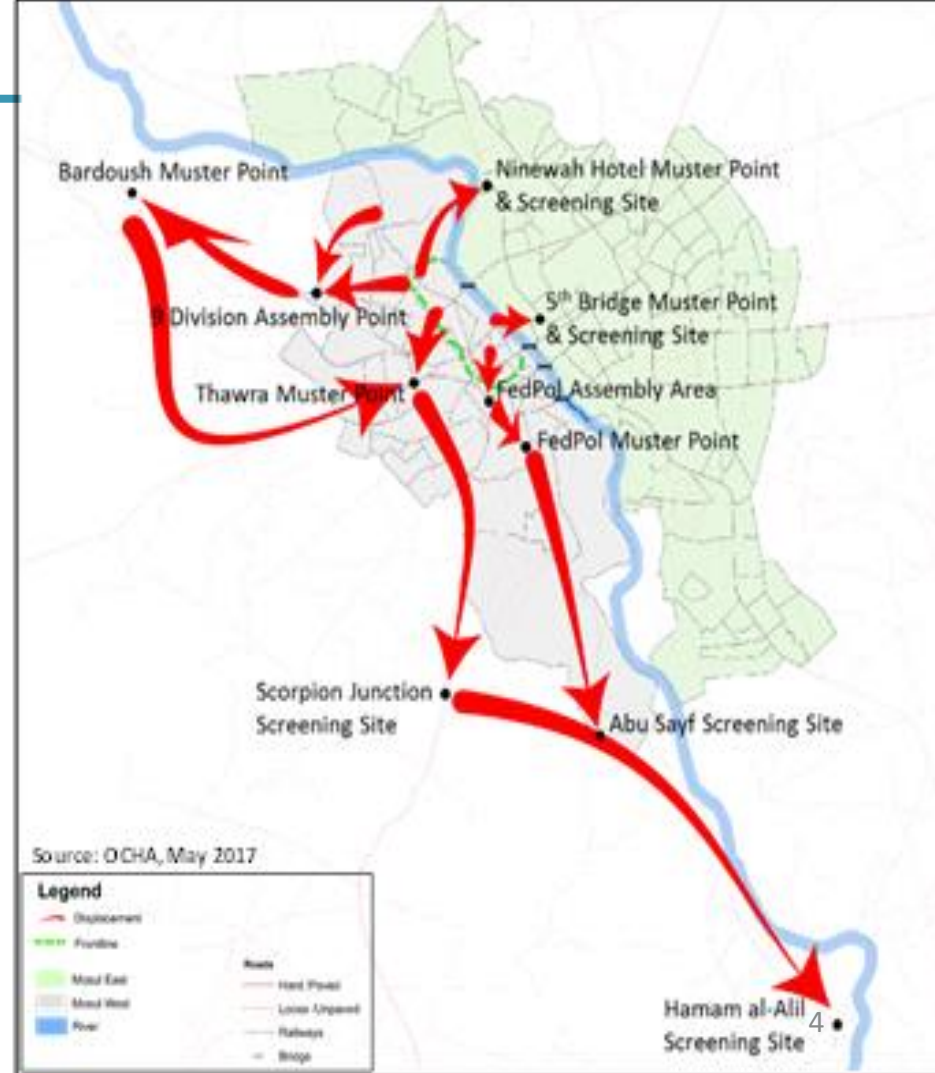

MOSUL RESPONSE

West Mosul Displacement Scenario

- Operational planning figure is **180,000** individuals who are residing in or around the Old City of Mosul.
- The current scenario is accounting for large scale displacements on a daily rate of **10,000** individuals per day with peak periods of **20,000** or more individuals per day.
- 5 expected displacement pathways:
 - Ninewah Hotel** mustering point & screening site
 - 9th Division** assembly point
 - Thawra** mustering point
 - Fed Pol** assembly & mustering points
 - 5th Bridge** mustering point & screening site
