Bi-weekly Update by partners

- WFP's reduced food ration for June was announced in JCC, ICCM, CCM and FSC meetings.
- WFP/ACTED cash assistance for May Cycle has been completed; 4,971 families received their assistance.
- WFP/ACTED E-voucher assistance for May Cycle has been completed; 2,927 families received their assistance.
- WFP/CDO In-kind distribution assistance for May has been completed; 10,440 families received their assistance.
- MoMD distributed 17,742 rations for the IDPs in all Camps in Sulaymaniyah and Garmyan .
- CDO distributed 234 food packages to the students of the hostels in the technical institute.
- IKL distributed 114 dry food baskets to the students of the hostels in Kalar District. In addition, IKL has also distributed hot meals to the students of Chamchamal District on the occasion of Ramadan (240 individuals).



- Runahi organization distributed vouchers to 420 vulnerable IDP and refugee families.

Action points

- Horizon Relief Organization has a plan to distribute its stock of 5000 food parcels to 4500 host community families in addition to 500 IDP in coordination with JCC. Horizon have been asked to cover 400 non WFP beneficiaries. WFP will coordinate with Garmyan JCC regarding the matter.
- BCF has a plan in Ramadan to distribute 1000 food baskets to 1000 IDP families in Suly center in addition to 800 host community families. There are also 500 host community families in Halabja and 500 ones in Ranya to be included.
- BCF have their own list of host community families. Those names were obtained through their own registration in coordination with JCC. As for the IDP list of names, the list was prepared according to the feedback coming from ACTED's complaint desk as well as CDO's hotline Dept. The targeted people have requested to receive assistance.
- In coordination with JCC, BCF has a plan to distribute food baskets in the areas of Barika and Zrgwez Sub Districts to Iranian refugees in Sulaymaniyah.
- CDO and BCF are to coordinate with JCC in Garmyan in order to provide assistance to the Iranian refugees
- ICRC conducted an assessment in Ranya for providing cash assistance, the assessment results will be shared upon finalization with FSC in July.
- STEP NGO's project is coming to an end, and for that, STEP will share their beneficiaries' list with FSC in order to continue the support of those vulnerable beneficiaries through the FSC members.

AOB

- Nadia Mahomed, food cluster coordinator attended the cluster meeting and will be attending on a regular basis. She requested the members to report their activities through activity info and members to let her know if they need training on activity info.
- From social affairs department, members of Children Hotline Center attended the meeting, aiming to connect with most of the clusters to be able to properly response and guide children and their families according to their needs and priorities. Food cluster asked them to send an official request so that food cluster links them to U operations center and advise them accordingly when their referred cases are food related. They are welcome to put them on our table for discussion.
