Bi-weekly Update by partners

- WFP food rations will be brought back to the 70.3kg.
- WFP/ACTED E-voucher distribution will start from 12-16 February, each individual will receive IQD 20,000.
- WFP/CDO in-kind distribution will start from 9-22; 12,525 families are targeted to receive assistance.
- REACH the local NGO's AA Syrian Refugee project is ongoing like previous months, 580 rations as follows: Ranya 389, Halabja 38, Said Sadiq 100 and Tasluja 53 families will be assisted.
- STEP the local NGO's distributions started on the 5<sup>th</sup> with a target of 271 beneficiaries.
- IKL distributed cash assistance to 81 IDP orphans, as well as 1,800 host community orphans. This assistance is distributed every two months with a budget of 190,000,000 IQD.
- IKL also distributed 100 meat rations to the same 81 IDP orphan families as well as 19 other families who randomly visited their office.
- CDO distributed assistance to 600 students who live in dorms in Old Halabja.



- All food cluster members were told to share their stock capacities and preparedness for the time of responding any influxes from Mosul if happens.

#### Action points

- JCC to confirm whether the IDPs in the areas of Sangaw and Qadir karam receive assistance or not.
- JCC to follow up on Qaratapa IDPs, to see whether they're returnees or not.
- CDO to inform WFP if they can do assessment in Qaratapa.
- Coordination to be held with UNHCR to resolve the issue of the lists and the deleted 30 families in Arbat Refugee camp, as well as filling any existing gap.
- IKL to work on distributing food assistance and NFI separately.
- WFP to coordinate with Garmyan JCC regarding distributions and IKL to provide their Garmyan office assistance distribution data
- Through cluster coordination, distribution points in different locations will be arranged for the 516 Fatherless families that receive assistance from IKL, those families used to visit Sulaymaniyah city to collect their assistance.
