Bi-weekly Update by partners

- WFP/CDO February in-kind distribution has been completed; 11,026 families received their assistance.
- WFP/ACTED Cash distribution has been completed, so far 5,416 families have received their assistance.
- WFP/ACTED E-voucher distribution has been completed, 3,543 families received their assistance.
- WFP/WVI E-voucher distribution for Syrian Refugees in Arbat Refugee Camp has been completed; out of the targeted 1,061 families, 1,036 of them received their assistance.
- The 30 mistakenly deleted families in Arbat Refugee camp are now re-included in the lists and they all received their February assistance.
- REACH the local NGO's AA project distribution for Syrian refugees took place, 580 vouchers were distributed to refugees in the locations of Ranya, Halabja, Said Sadiq and Tasluja.
- STEP the local NGO's distributions started on the 5th with a target of 271 beneficiaries.



- IKL distributed cash assistance to 81 IDP orphans, as well as 1,800 host community orphans. This assistance is distributed every two months with a budget of 190,000,000 IQD.
- IKL also distributed 100 meat rations to the same 81 IDP orphan families as well as 19 other families who randomly visited their office.
- JCC has distributed 31 rations to refugees in Dukan and 21 in Piramagroom. As well as distributing 40 rations in Sulaymaniyah for host community and IDPs.
- All food cluster members were told to share their stock capacities and preparedness for the time of responding any influxes from Mosul if happens.

#### Action points

- CDO to inform WFP if they can do assessment in Qaratapa.
- IKL to work on distributing food assistance and NFI separately.
- WVI to coordinate with UNHCR regarding the changed registry forms in Arbat Refugee Camp.
- Through cluster coordination, distribution points in different locations will be arranged for the 516 Fatherless families that receive assistance from IKL, those families used to visit Sulaymaniyah city to collect their assistance.

#### AOB

- CC confirmed that not all IDPs in the areas of Sangaw and Qadir Karam receive WFP assistance; those who receive assistance, collect their vouchers in Chamchamal Distribution point.
- Qaratapa's issues are to be addressed to Garmyan JCC
