Bi-weekly Update by partners

- WFP/CDO January in-kind distribution has been completed; 11,261 families received their assistance.
- WFP/ACTED Cash distribution has been completed; 5,519 families have received their assistance.
- WFP/ACTED E-voucher distribution has been completed, 3,583 families received their assistance.
- WFP/WVI E-voucher distribution for Syrian Refugees in Arbat Refugee Camp has been completed; out of the targeted 1,015 families, 984 of them received their assistance.
- STEP the local NGO's 300 package assistance distribution has started and is ongoing in the areas of Chamchamal, Old Halabja, Dukan and Ranya.
- MoDM has distributed 850 food baskets in Old Halabja, Sirwan and Khurmal areas on January 23rd.
- REACH the local NGO's AA project distribution for Syrian refugees started on January 15 and ended on 19 in the following locations: Ranya 389 families, Halabja 38, Said Sadiq 100, Tasluja 53 families were assisted.



- IKL distributed cash assistance to 81 IDP orphans, as well as 1,500 host community orphans. This assistance is distributed every two months with a budget of 150,000,000 IQD
- All food cluster members were told to share their stock capacities and preparedness for the time of responding any influxes from Mosul if happens.

Action points

- WFP to share the name of the four new IDP families in Tazade Camp with STEP.
- Food security members with food stock capacities will be encouraged, coordinated and cooperated to cover gaps, or excluded families due to the WFP targeting criteria.
- JCC coordination and cooperation is ongoing to facilitate more with the local administration in term of providing better distribution points at some towns and districts within Sulaymaniyah governorate
