

MONTHLY MARKET MONITORING BULLETIN

Issue Number: 19

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Background

The market price data and information is collected from seven FSIS Programme target Governorates through the Governorate Focal Units (GFU) and FSTS in Sana'a City. The prices are collected from Hodeida, Hajjah, Dhamar, Hadramout, Lahej, Taiz and Sana'a City markets. The prices are collected from at least three (3) representative market centers and average is calculated for each location. The market-monitoring bulletin provides tables and charts that show the monthly prices in the targeted Governorate markets. It also provides and allows the users to compare the current prices with the previous month and the pre-crisis average.



Key Highlights

- Globally:** The FAO Food Price Index (FFPI) averaged 175.5 points in February and is as much as 26 points, or 17.2%, higher than its level in the corresponding month last year and at its highest value since February 2015. FAO Cereal Price Index, which averaged 150.6 points in February, 3.7 points (2.5 percent) from January 2017. The benchmark US wheat price for Gulf averaged USD 201 per ton, more than 7% up from December 2016, but still 6 percent lower than a year earlier (FAO - FPMA February 2017).
- Consumer Price Index (CPI) and inflation rate:** According to CSO (2017), the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all products during December 2015 and December 2016 was 240.61 and 269.235 and the annual inflation for all products was 11.9%. The annual inflation rate for the same period for food items and non-alcoholic beverages was 9.74% while the monthly inflation rate between November and December 2016 for all products was 2.90%.
- Imported commodities:** In February, the average prices of imported basic food commodities showed a significant increase compared to the previous month in all targeted governorates. The increase reached 9.7% for beans, 7.54% for Rice and above 4% for sugar, vegetable oil, and wheat flour and wheat grains. At the same time, the monthly average prices of all imported products increased above 34% when compared to pre-crisis period
- Locally produced Cereals:** The average price of barley increased by 1.94% in February 2017 while the average price of other locally produced cereals dropped by less than 3% compared to the prices of January 2017. However, the prices are still higher by 46% for both Sorghum and Millet, by 59% for Maize and 78% for Barley when compared with pre crisis prices.
- Fuel Commodities:** A significant increase in the average prices of all fuel items almost in all target governorates was recorded in February compared to January 2017. Diesel increased above 20% in Sana'a city, Hodeidah, Hajjah and Dhamar. Petrol followed the same trends of diesel, where it increased sharply by around 23% in Taiz and between 3.83% and 16.88% in the other governorates. Cooking gas recorded the highest price in Taiz (7000 YR/18 kg) followed by Lahej, Hajjah and Sana'a city.
- Availability of food commodities in the local markets:** At the time of reporting, all monitored commodities were available in the local markets of Hadramout and Hajjah governorates. While imported sorghum, maize and barley were scarcely available in some markets in Dhamar. Similarly, Thamad, Sakhla and Bagha fish were scarcely available in the governorates of Hodeida, Lahej and Taiz. Lower fodder prices, encourages breeders to keep their flocks of sheep and goats rather to sell, this made its less supply that resulted in limited availability and higher prices for the single alive head in Lahej during February compared to the previous month.

 January 2015 -February 2017

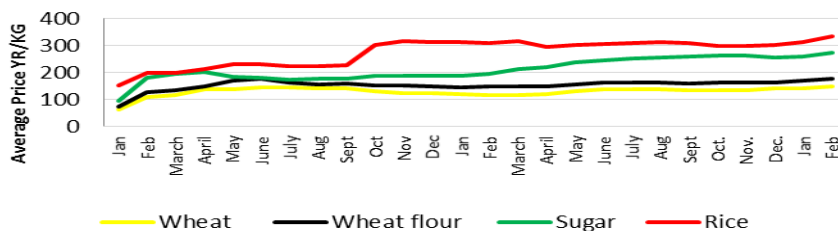

Fig 2. Average Retail Prices of Locally produced cereals (YR/Kg) January 2015- February 2017

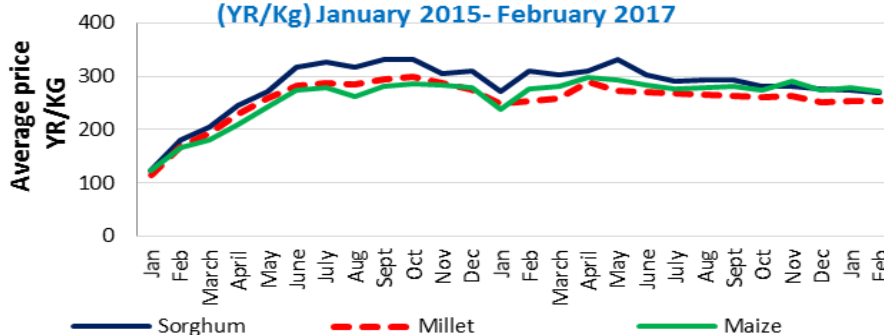

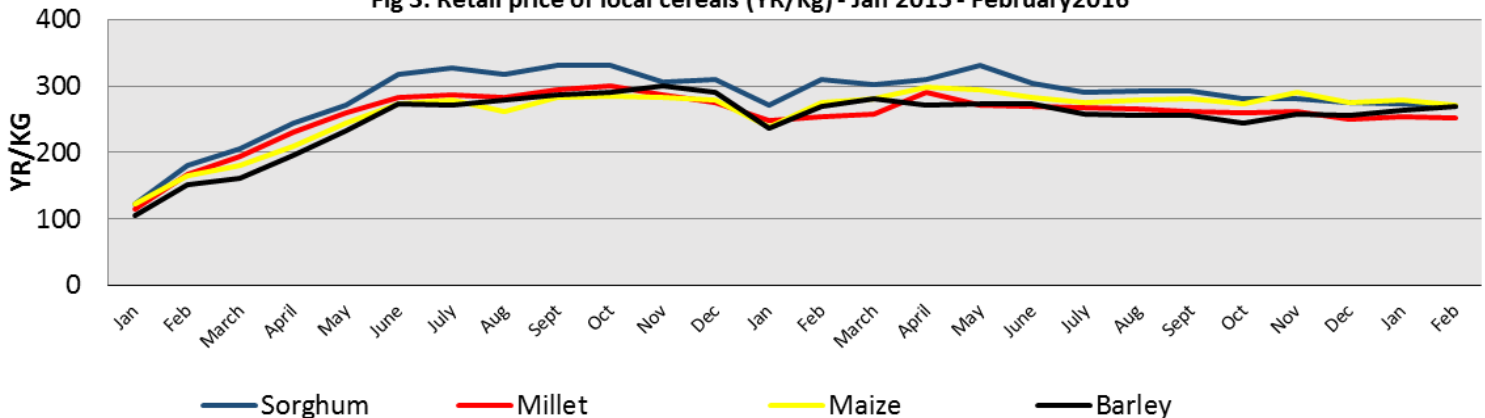
- **Millet:** The average prices of millet in February 2017 remained the same when compared to January 2016 in Hodeida and Taiz. However, there was an increase in average prices of millet by 15.5% in Sana'a city, and by 3.9% in Hajjah. The prices of millet in Hadramout remains very high (125.3%) followed by Al Hodeidah by 72.44% compared to the pre-crisis period.

- **Maize:** In February, the average price of maize increased by 6.1% in Hajjah and by 2.9% in Hadramout. Prices declined by 12.7% in Taiz, 11.2% in Lahej and by less than 3% in Hodeidah and Dhamar Governorates.

- **Barley:** The average price declined in Hajjah by 14.2% and remained the same as of January 2017 in Lahej. Prices increased by 25% in Hodeidah, 3.7% in Hadramout, and declined by 1.3% in Taiz. Local barley prices in Al Hodeidah is the highest (188.5%) compared to the pre-crisis prices followed by Taiz (97.3%) and Sana'a city by 57.9%.

- **Sorghum:** The average prices of sorghum in February showed the highest decline by 12.7% in Hodeidah, followed by 11.2% in Lahej; by 2.7% in Dhamar. The prices however increased by 16.6% in Hajjah, 3.6% in Taiz, and by 2.3 % in Sana'a city. The prices of sorghum remained high with more than 75% in Taiz and by 57.5% in Hodeidah and by 46.8% in Hadramout when compared to the pre-crisis prices in February 2015.

Onions: Average prices of onions in February 2017 remained the same as of January 2017 in Sana'a city and Hajjah while it sharply declined in other target governorates. The highest decline was 22.68% in Taiz followed by 16.91% in Dhamar and 15.50% in Hodeidah.

- **Tomatoes:** Due to increased production of tomatoes in the coastal areas and mid altitude areas, which resulted in more supply, the average prices of tomatoes in February was much lower in comparison to January 2017 in most of the targeted governorates. The decrease in prices was highest in Hodeida by 32%, Hajjah 27% and Dhamar 11%. While in prices increased sharply by 71% in Lahej and slightly by 8.7% in Taiz.

- **Potatoes:** The average prices in February declined in all targeted governorates. The highest price decline was recorded in Lahej by 31% followed by 27% in Hajjah and by 24% in Hadramout and Taiz.

- **Pepper & Chilly:** There was a sharp decrease in the monthly average price of pepper compared to January 2017 in most target governorates. It remained the same in Sana'a city and rose by 10.13% in Taiz. The prices of chilly decreased in five target governorates between less than one percent in Dhamar and 24.00% in Hodeidah. It increased in Lahej sharply by 20.85% and in Taiz by 1.43% compared to January 2017. In general, the prices of vegetables vary almost every month due to seasonality, and forces of demand and supply.

Wheat grains: The average retail price of wheat grains remained the same as in January 2017 Lahej, Dhamar and Taiz while increased sharply by 17.39% in Hajjah, 9.35% in Hadramout and equally in Sana'a city and Hodeidah. However, the prices are still higher by 75.32% in Hajjah, 36.36% in Dhamar, and 28.00% in Hodeida and 11.54% in Sana'a city when compared to the pre-crisis prices.

Wheat Flour: The average retail prices of Wheat flour increased almost in all governorates except Lahej. Prices increased by 6% in Hajjah, above 9% in Taiz, 7.24% in Hadramout and by 4.62% in Sana'a city. On the other hand, average prices are much higher by 59% in Hajjah, 30% in Hodeida, 72% in Taiz, 39.23% in Sana'a City, 13.33% in Dhamar and 16.43% in Hadramout when compared to the pre-crisis prices.

Rice: The average prices of non-basmati rice (non-Basmati) increased by 14.01% in Sana'a city, 15% in Dhamar, 21.24% in Hajjah 2.90 and 2% in Hadramout and Lahej respectively. The imported Basmati increased in all governorates, where it raised by 12.53% in Taiz, 9.94% in Hodeidah, 6.51% in Sana'a city and remained the same as of January 2017 in Dhamar

Sugar: The average monthly prices in February, increased in all targeted governorates except Taiz compared to the previous month. Highest increased by 13.20% was in Hajjah, above 4% in Sana'a City and Lahej and 7.08% in Hodeidah. However, the prices are still higher by 87.50% in Taiz, 76.88% in Sana'a city and 58.82% in Dhamar and 42.93% in Hajjah when compared to the prices of pre-crisis era.

Cooking Oil: In February 2017, the average prices of locally processed oil increased in all governorates, while the imported ones decreased in Hodeidah by 6%, and by 5.31% in Hajjah. The imported cooking oil prices went up in Taiz by 3.45% and Hadramout by 13.16% compared to January 2017.

Faba-beans & Lentils The prices of Faba-beans during February remained the same in Hodeidah, increased by 14.58% in Sana'a city, by 2.46 in Hajjah and by less than 3% in Hadramout, while it decreased in Dhamar by less than 2%. Other beans in February increased in Sana'a city by 14.80% for beans and by 3.25% for lentil, while lentils prices remained the same as January 2017 in Hodeida and Dhamar but increased by 7.60% in Lahej and less than 2% in Taiz.

Thamad: In February, the Thamad fish was not available in Hodeidah and Hajjah for six months in a row and increased sharply by 42.64% in Hadramout, 34.20% in Lahej due to the crises of fuel and 4.11% in Taiz Compared to the previous month.

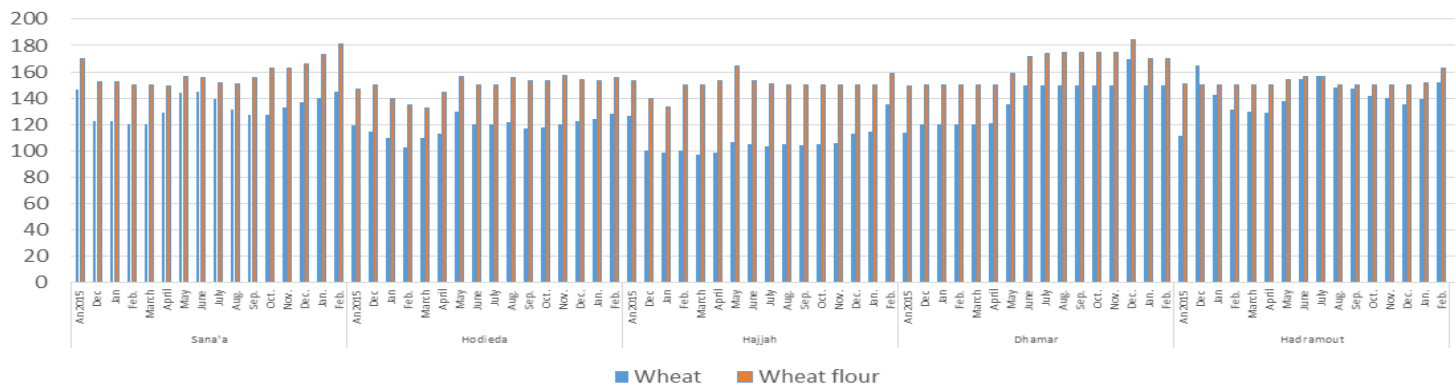
Sakhla: This type of fish was not available in Lahej and Taiz for the sixth months in a row. Average prices of Sakhla fish showed increased prices compared to January 2017 in all target governorates by 8.56% in Dhamar, 10.71% in Hajjah, 16.91% in Sana'a city and less than 10% in Hodeidah.

Bagha: The average prices of Bagha fish in February increased in Sana'a city and Hodeida by 53.33% and 24.51% respectively when compared to previous month. However, this type of fish was not available in Taiz Governorate markets since September 2016.

Jahsh: Average prices of Jahsh fish decreased by less than 2% in Hajjah, while it increased in all other target governorates, Sana'a City, 15.79%, by 12.12% in Dhamar, by 31% in Lahej and by 41.80%, Hadramout,

Availability and supply: At the time of reporting, all fish types reflected its scarcity, less supply, fuel prices increase and as a result higher prices compared to the previous month. Seasonality and weather factors play important roles in the market supply and price fluctuation for all fish types in Yemen. It should be noted that there is no fishing activities in the coast of Taiz due to the current security situation and the main supply coming from Aden market

Sheep - 6 and 12 months old: In February, the monthly average prices of both types of sheep showed a decreasing trend in Lahej, Dhamar, and Hadramout governorates. Hajjah, Taiz, Hodeidah and Sana'a City recorded increasing trends, compared to January 2017 prices. The highest price increase was 18.6% in Hajjah market for the six-month old sheep and in Hodeidah by 8.70% for both ages.

Goat - 6 and 12 months old: The average prices of 6 months old goats remained the same as of January 2017 in Hodeidah, decreased in Sana'a city by 2.15%, by 8.18% in Lahej and by less than 1% in Hadramout. The highest price of the single head of 12 month goat was in Hadramout (48,833 YR), followed by Taiz (42167 YR) and Sana'a city (32125 YR)

Live chicken: Compared to January 2017, the average price of live chicken in February showed decreasing trend in all governorates. Highest decrease was by 12% in Hajjah.

Note: The average prices of live animals from Hodeida, the Tihamah area of Hajjah, and west of Dhamar are from the primary markets, which is closer to the farmers or producer price. On the other hand, the prices from Sana'a City, Hadramout, Taiz and Lahej are collected inside the city considered as secondary markets.

- **Beef:** In February, the average prices of one kg of beef remained unchanged as of January 2017 in Sana'a city and unavailable in Lahej governorates. Prices went up in Hadramout by 5.91% and declined sharply by 16% in Hajjah and by less than 3% in Taiz and Hodeidah.
- **Mutton:** The average prices of mutton followed nearly the same trends of beef, where prices remained the same as of January 2017 in Sana'a city, Lahej, and Dhamar. Prices decreased by 5.02%, 1.20% and less than 1 percent in Hodeidah, Taiz and Hajjah respectively
- **Local Cow's Milk:** The average price remained unchanged in Sana'a city, Hodeidah and Dhamar, and Lahej; while in Hadramout the prices decreased by 5%. Prices however increased by 4.21% in Taiz
- **Processed Powdered Milk:** The average prices of processed milk in February increased sharply in Hadramout by 21.66% and between 4% and 6% in Dhamar, Hodeidah and Lahej, when compared to January 2017 prices.
- **Chicken Meat:** Compared to the previous month, the average price of chicken meat remained the same in Sana'a city, increased in Dhamar by 12.57% and by 4.23% in Hodeidah. Prices decreased by 3.85% in Lahej and by less than 2% in Taiz
- **Eggs:** Compared to January 2017, the average prices of 30 eggs in February declined in three governorates Hajjah, Dhamar and Lahej. It increased in Hadramout by 5.19%, Taiz by 2% and in Sana'a city by less than 2 percent

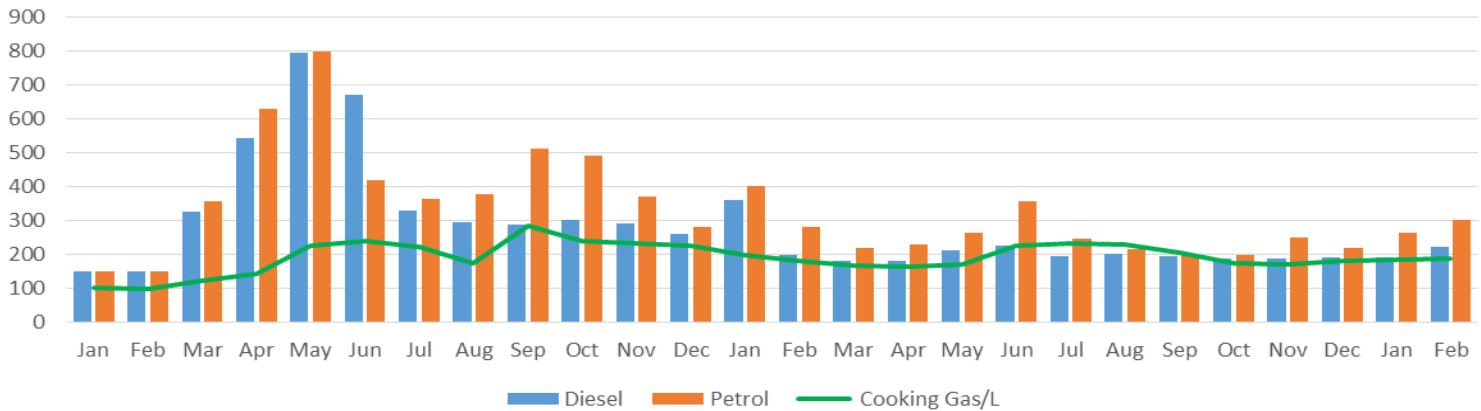

- Petrol:** The average price of a single liter of petrol price went up in February in all targeted governorates. It increased sharply by 22.9% in Taiz, 13.2% in Dhamar, 11.7% in Hodeidah, and by 14.2% in Sana'a city compared to January 2017. However, the current average monthly prices are still higher by 136.0% in Taiz, 214% in Lahj, 78.7% in Hodeida and above 84.7% in Hajjah when compared to the pre-crisis time
- Cooking Gas:** In February, the average price of the single cylinder of cooking gas (18 kg) was ranging from 1917 YR in Hadramout to 7000 YR in Taiz, which is the highest, compared to all monitored markets and 180.0% higher than the pre-crisis prices. The average prices of cooking gas decreased in February when compared to January 2017 in Hadramout by 22% and by less than 1% in Lahej.

- Diesel:** In February, the average price of a single liter of diesel remained the same as of January 2017 only in Lahej. It increased sharply compared to the previous month by 25.8% in Sana'a city, 21.6% Hodeidah, and 22.6% in Hajjah, by 13% in Taiz markets. However, the price is still significantly higher than the pre-crisis period by 85.3% in Taiz, 55.3% in Hajjah by 58.7% in Dhamar and 16.7% in Hadramout.
