### **Main Discussion points**

1. Seed distribution through the ELRP 2018. FAO targets to reach 730, 000 HH (4.3 beneficiaries) in 2018 with crop kits, vegetable kits and fishing kits for both main season and dry season. The beneficiaries are expected to produce about 300,000 MT of food from the support. The main season livelihood support targets greater Equatoria, (90,000 HH), Greater Upper Nile (105,500 HH) and Greater Bahr el Ghazal (204, 500 HH)

2. New ICWG prioritization process. The FSL cluster prioritization in 2018 will be based on the IPC analysis (planned response) as well as rapid response to take care of unforeseen changes in the context (conflict, displacements, partner capacity gaps, pipeline breaks etc). Three main working groups have been formed to handle the inter cluster prioritization process: -
  - a) Needs Analysis Working Group
  - b) ICWG
  - c) Operational Working Group

3. FSL cluster GBV prevention & mainstreaming capacity assessment & action plan for 2018. In line with the national focus on “Protection against Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA), the FSL cluster conducted an assessment to establish the capacity of its membership as far as GBV mainstreaming is concerned. Based on the assessment results and a risk analysis, the following 4 action points have been identified: -

- a) Development of simple tools, PSEA pocket books and improve existing measures to ensure “do no harm” in humanitarian aid delivery.
- b) Promotion of GBV prevention mainstreaming
- c) Partners to share good practice & lessons learnt
- d) Resource mobilization
