### 1. Review of SAG TOR:

Brief review of SAG ToR was done and following Key roles of SAG were discussed:

Support FSL coordination process and advocate on the FSL-C response strategy, especially providing support on:

- Reviewing strategy paper coming from Technical working group
- Facilitating SSHF selection process
- Reviewing of concept notes
- Reading and awarding of the project

Support of SAG members on Technical Working group:

- Provide strategic guidance on AWG, LWG and CASH working group.
- Strategy paper, ToRs of each technical groups are being drafted and will be shared with members soon
- SAG should focus on 4/5 main priorities and provide strategic support to cluster and TWG.
- To be shared with members work plans/ToRs of TWG (Ntando to share by September 5<sup>th</sup>)
- How do we keep our communication- external or internal?
- Inviting other Cluster partners in CASH working group meeting would be better. (For example, NFI, Education Cluster, and some non-humanitarian cash based programme, for eg, Girls education in south Sudan.

### 2. Key roles and times of the year

The **key roles and times of the year** when SAG members are anticipated to be active reviewing strategies & technical documents were done. Following key roles of SAG was discussed:

- Developing the HNO – Sept/ Oct (Alistair/ Ntando to send on ICWG timeline when available)
- Developing the HRP – Nov/ Dec
- Reviewing TWG products – ad hoc
- Discussed about another round of SSHF call for this year between now and Christmas and possible engagement of SAG members on FSL proposal selection

### 3. Updates from technical working groups:

#### Updates of CWG groups

- Experts for CASH working group expected to join early September and review the current strategy and lead the CWG.
- Wednesday, 30<sup>th</sup> August 2017 there will be meeting on CASH working group.
- Cluster to share the CWG strategy- reviewed by DCA.
- Discussed about active cash technical groups- there is no educational cash technical group. However there is very small cash technical working group for NFIs.
- Discussion was made on possible coordination mechanism between OCHA, WFP, DCA and other partners and lead for CASH technical group.
- David from OCHA developed a draft ToR for harmonization, cluster is ready to share

#### Updates from other technical working groups: (Ntando to send on strategy/ guidelines as they become available for review)

- Next week draft strategy paper will be released for AWG
- Election for co-lead for Agriculture Technical working group will be held soon.

### 4. Cluster updates:

FSL cluster coordinator updated about the FSL cluster response prioritization including prioritization for ICWG II and ICWG III.

#### Prioritization for ICWG II

##### Jonglei: Uror/ Nyirol/ Duk & Ayod islands/ Pigi

- Response but still under served; NGOs returning after evacuation;

##### Upper Nile: Longuchuk & Maiwut

- Pagak – active conflict; Udier increasing IDPs from Pagak (22k to 45k) do ICRC & RI need more assistance?

##### Equatorias: Mundri/ Mvolo (Yeri GAM 28%/ SAM 9%) & Terekeka

- Worsening food crisis/ hunger deaths: access issues for 29k WFP distribution (MM) & data shortages (T)

#### Prioritization for ICWG III

**Identifying gaps:** Are there any priority areas that we are either (1) not responding to sufficiently well or (2) lacking data to make the decision to respond?
