Agenda Item 1: Matters arising from the previous minutes.

- ❖ Still some agencies namely CHADO, VSF- Suisse, Mercycorp and DRC didn't submit their 5Ws but they have all confirm to submit today to the cluster.
- ❖ JAM and DRC have set and agreed on area targeted by each of them that JAM shouldn't target population in Tong, Juage, Pakur and Ding-ding villages of Rubkona county in coming rainy season livelihood assistance.
- ❖ Blood sample was collected by FAO from infected cattle by FMD disease in Rubkona and Guit counties, samples to be send to Juba for laboratory analysis.

Action Point: FAO to update the cluster next meeting about the result analysis.

Agenda Item 2: Youths support at PoCs by livelihood activities .

- ❖ DRC, WHH and CHADO are assigned to come up with program or concept note about program that can engage youth in any useful sort of livelihood activities. Proposed options listed during their discussions to be forwarded to members.

Agenda Item 3:FSL Partners Updates for last two weeks.

(1).Welthungerhilfe (WHH):

- ❖ Completed February 2017 GFD cycle. Food distribution for the month of March commenced; Dingding was served already, distribution ongoing in Bentiu Town and the POC.
- ❖ Grinding mills activities ongoing, with one grinding mill installed in Bentiu town.

(2).Joint Aid Management (JAM)



- ❖ Distribution of livelihood kits (vegetable seeds and fishing gears) in all Payams of Guit county was done two weeks ago targeted 4,046 HHs.
- ❖ Livestock supplies (vaccines and drags) were received last week and this is meant for livestock intervention in Rubkona county.
- ❖ A 15 days training for 12 new Community Based Animal Health Workers (CBAHWs) was concluded yesterday 14th March 2017 in Rubkona county.
- ❖ Plan to conduct practical training on vegetable crop production next week.

(4). MercyCorp (MC):

- ❖ Registration of 2500 vulnerable households and 40 traders were done for both Bentiu & Rubkona.
- ❖ Data entering is completely done and the list has been send to the program management in Juba for final analysis and resend the lists back to Bentiu so that the lists should share with WFP & the WHH to confirm the registered beneficiaries in the general food assistance lists and after that they will get their cash assistance.
- ❖ Markets assessment was done last Thursday in-order to monitor the food commodities price as it's the one factor of cash assistance.

(5). Norwegian People Aid (NPA):

- ❖ Food distribution in Kuach/ Niemni was successfully completed for the month of March
- ❖ No food distributions in February due to pipe line break
- ❖ NPA and WFP to discuss further on the way forward for grinding mill project implementation in Guit County

(5) Danish Refugee Council (DRC):

- ❖ From 28th Feb- 3rd March 2017, they completed registration of CFW beneficiaries in Juach, Pakur, Tong, Dingding, and Rubkona town for 328 HHs of 90 males and 238 females.
- ❖ Prepared and facilitates signing of casual labour contracts on 6th -8th March 2017 by CFW beneficiaries in Juach, Tong, Pakur, Dingding and Rubkona town (328 HH beneficiaries. Males 90 and females 238).
- ❖ Have monitored the implementation for cash for work activities in 5 locations mentioned above.
- ❖ Planned and has started beneficiaries' registration of for Seeds, tools and fishing kits in Dingding, Tong, Pakur, Juach. That is 4300 HH. On 15/03/2017.
- ❖ Dry season livelihood kit assistance to four (4) locations as shown below and the standard supply per each household for the livelihood kit is shown on Annex 1;

(6) World Food Program (WFP):

- ❖ Food assistance for the famine-prone counties ongoing (i.e. Leer, Koch, Panyijar) except Mayendit where security is still a concern.
- ❖ Food assistance is completed in Ngop locations in Mayom and will continue in the other four (4) locations by the close of the month.



(7) CHADO:

- ❖ Selection of 15 volunteer for Bentiu and Rubkona town.
- ❖ Establishment of demonstration farm in Bentiu town started.

(8) VSF-CH

- ❖ 2 session Community awareness on zoonosis diseases (Anthrax, TB, Brucellosis & Rabies ,in Rubkona targets 50 paxs concluded 2nd Mar 2017
- ❖ Five days Refresher Training for 20 community animals health workers (CAHWS) concluded on 6th mar.2017 in Rubkona
- ❖ Livestock Vaccination campaign is ongoing at Nhaildiu,Kaljak and Norlam and the number that were vaccinated at Rubkona and its surrounding reach up to 20050 animals
- ❖ VSF –CH carryout Diseases outbreak investigation (FMD) in Rubkona,Babnos and Tong cattle camps ,report share with FAO in JUBA.in Mar 2017.

Agenda Item 4: AOB

- ❖ IOM as CCCM coordinator for PoC have shared their new program “ Women’s Participation in Camp Life and Governance Structures” in Bentiu PoCs. The main components of the program include;
 - ✓ Women’s Governance Structure.
 - ✓ Adult Education.
 - ✓ Fuel Efficient Stoves (FES)
 - ✓ Small Grants/ quick impact project.

Action Point: FAO to provide IOM with FES’s report of last year, this shall serve as lesson learn reference for IOM consultant who is coming to conduct experiment on FES in the PoCs
