168,208 animals vaccinated

Plans:

Vaccination of nomadic herder's animals

Poultry vaccination in D1, D2 and Khor Ador

Funding dependant:

WV may distribute staple seeds through seed fair /general livelihood kit distribution in Melut, Renk and Malakal this season (rain season) if the proposal is approved and funded

GOAL Intervention Plans:

Staple Crop: 50

Fishing Kit: 200

Vegetable Kit: 264

Cash Transfers: 1500 (Khor Ador: 400, D1: 700, D2: 200(tentative), Melut: 100, Paloich: 100)

Land access remains a serious issue, and predicted to be more so in the upcoming staple season. NGOs need to coordinate to ensure land access for IDPs.

Need for thoughts around identifying host community to ensure no overlap in input distributions

GOAL to contact FSL Juba Cluster re: assessment of Baliet situation, now that people should be returning to plant.	The January assessment will now be redundant but informal reports imply that only soldiers still reside in Baliet.	31 st March
All NGOs to share beneficiary lists with WFP reference number, for IDPs.	Help coordinate new beneficiary selection and avoid overlap	13 th April (when available)
