Introduction

Partners shared a quick introduction to introduce themselves and the NGOs they presented in the Sub-FSAC meeting.

Reviewing Last meeting action points

Meeting minutes was reviewed and approved by the partners.

Participation / Partnership of Local NGOs in the Sub-FSAC.

Recently numbers of local NGOs operating in Hudaydah hub are requesting to be partner in the Sub-FSAC , to make sure all partners in the Sub-FSAC meet the criteria of being active FSAC partner in the hub few guidelines were discussed and kindly requested from the interested local NGOs :

- Organization profile.
- Is the NGO officially registered and what the registration number is.
- Is the NGO active in FSAC / Conducting activities?
- Is there any planned activities, if Yes then when, what, which governorate, which districts, and what is the funding status.



Then these information provided by the interested partners will be reviewed and either accepted or rejected, if accepted the NGO must be fully committed to be active partner in the FSAC . It was clarified that the Sub-FSAC doesn't have the capacity to accommodate other than FSAC partners.

Issues addressed by the local authorities regarding sub-FSAC partner's presence and activities.

Both Hajjah and Hudaydah executive unit raise several concerns regarding the FSAC partners and the activities implemented I the hub and how it affected the communities , from these concerns was the limited impact of the response in comparison with the huge and increased needs , the lack of commitment from the FSAC partners to attend the monthly coordination meetings , no commitment to the standard food baskets that is being distributed by the partners which caused continues problems from the community , other issues was related to WFP specifically and was shared with them for their feedback and action , with regard to the cluster the Sub-FSAC will keep encouraging the partner to increase their assistance and remain the coordination with the local authorities .

Partners updates for the month / upcoming activities and plans / Challenges:

VHI : For December (In Hajjah) funded by WFP they finish distributing Food Basket for 27477 HH in (Ashhahil – Maghrabah – Miftah – Hajjah – Hajjah rural – Kuhlan Affrar – Nagrah – Shares) . In Hudaydah they distributed FB funded by WFP and implemented by PAD (Partnership association for development) in Kamaran targeting 700 HHs and in Salif 1000 HHs .

Hudaydah Girls : Distributed bean cans for the orphan families in Hali , Hawak and Mina for 96 HHs .

OXFAM : They finished the first round of UCT for 2072 HHs in Abs targeting beneficiaries with 98 \$ per round per HH , also they distributed livestock support for 60 HHs in Ban Hasan . They are planning to distribute UTC support for IDPs and host community in Abs for 1508 HH IDPs and 780 HHs from Host communities , also CFW activity for 500 HHs and livelihood support for 90 HHs fom January – March 2017 .

Abu Musa : Finish distributing food baskets for affected population , 5250 FB in Azzuhrah and Alluhayah supported by private charitable individual .



NRC : Funded by WFP they finished distributing food commodity for 17142 HH for December in (Qofl Shammer – Bakil Almir – Washaa – Mahabisha – Qarah) in Hajjah . For Hudaydah a new project for 4 cycles up to April 2017 in Qanawis , Zuhrah and Alluhayah funded by DFID targeting 3000 HHs with UCT in Zuhrah and Qanawis , 200 CFW in Azzuhrah , 450 with agricultural inputs in Azzuhrah . Another project funded by ECHO targeting 1514 HHs with UCT in Zuhrrah and Alluhaya with 98 \$ per HH for 2 cycles.

ADO : distributed cash assistance for the most vulnerable families in Abs , the amount varies between 10000 –20000 YER per HH and its self-funded .

FAO : they are supporting beneficiaries in Hajjah and Hudaydah with agricultural inputs , dairy milk producing tools around 4123 HHs in both governorates , A new feeding block was opened in Halqah (Hudaydah).

ACF : Finished the first round of the new ECHO project , UCT support for 450 HH in Khawkah and 500 HH in Jabal Ra's for 3 cycles . For livestock support targeting 170 HHs in both Khawkah and Jabal Ra's with 2 goats per HH for 1 time (1 round ended in January 2017) . They have a new project in Abs to distributed food commodity in abs for 1130 HHs with food voucher for 3 months (24500 YER per HH) this project is funded by OCHA .

IRY : They finished supporting 79087 HHs in Jabal Ras, Al Marawya, Az Zuhra, Alluheyra, Al Hujjayla, Bagil, Alhali, Al Mena'a, Bayt Al Faqih, Zabeed, Az Zaydiya, Al Qanawes districts (Hudaydah) funded by WFP .
