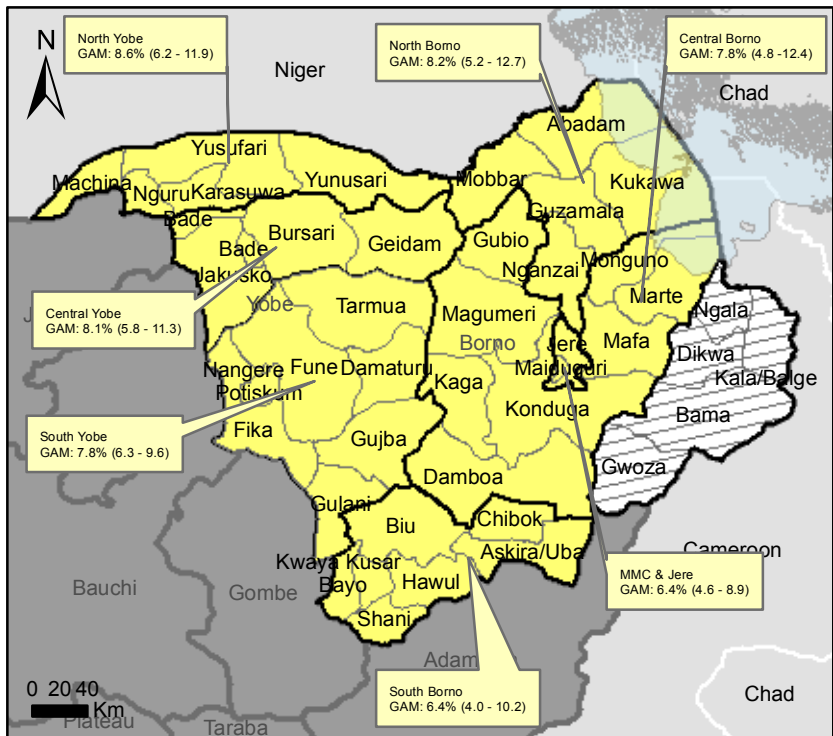
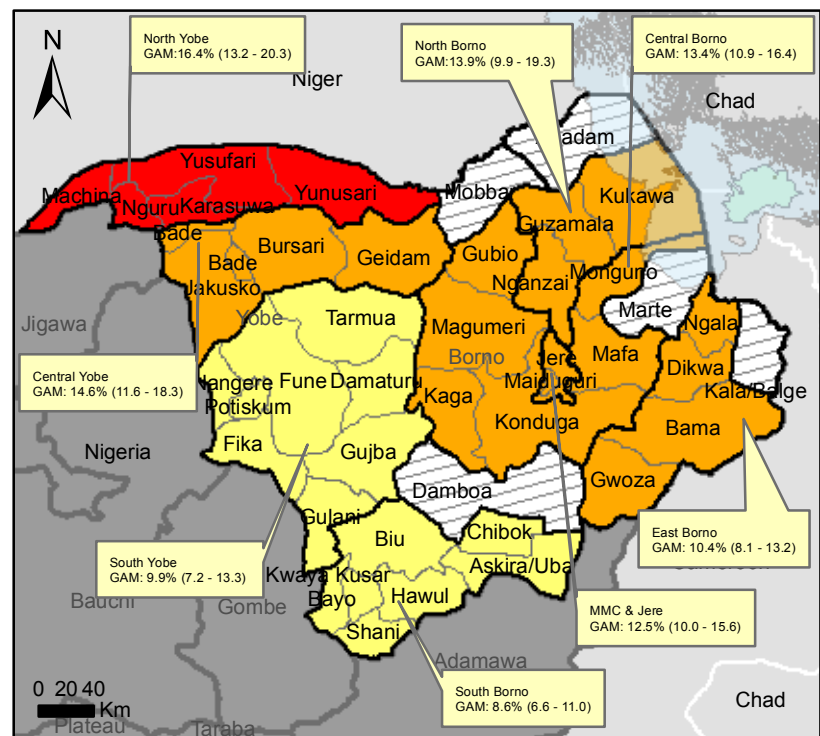


Round 1: Oct - Nov 2016
