



FOOD SECURITY SECTOR CASH DASHBOARD | NORTH EAST NIGERIA | MAY 2020

In May 2020, the Food Security Sector assisted **2,331,565** unique individuals, of whom **61% (1,432955)** received assistance through Cash Voucher Assistance (CVA). Thirty-three organizations, including national and international NGOs and UN agencies, applied various transfer delivery mechanisms, such as cash in hand, mobile money transfers, paper vouchers and electronic vouchers. Of those assisted with CVA, **68% (978,060)** were under SO1 (Food Assistance) while **32% (454,895)** under SO2 (Agriculture and Livelihoods). Borno state hosts the highest caseload, approximately 72% of the CVA beneficiaries, compared to 25% and 3% in Yobe and Adamawa states, respectively.
