RESPONSE

Rohingva and Bangladeshi host communities remain vulnerable, with overall vulnerability of both populations remain high in 2023 (WFP REVA 6), Food Security Sector (FSS) partners are targeting all Rohingva refugees living inside the 33 camps and 376.530 host community individuals who are most vulnerable in Ukhiya and Teknaf Upazila to improve communities' food security and resilience.

19 F-voucher outlets and 18 Fresh Food Corner were operational across the Ukihya and Teknaf Upazilas located in 33 Rohingva camps.

30% of Rohingya population who are most vulnerable received fresh food voucher assistance (\$3 top up) to purchase additional food from FFCs.
























Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh | Non-JRP Host Community Gap Analysis (north of Ukhia and Teknaf) January to June, 2023
