Food Security and Livelihood

Emergency Food Assistance

- A one off 50% ration 15 days (for short-term emergencies)
- In IPC 4 counties with pockets of IPC 5 a 70% ration is provided for 8 months.
- In all other IPC 4 locations will receive a 50% ration for a 5 to 7 months' period (dependent upon resources).

Livelihood & Livestock Support

- Floods: fishing kits (twine, monofilament & hooks); and where appropriate a vegetable kit (3 quick maturing varieties + tool) for flood emergencies.
- Other emergencies: emergency crop kit (cereal, pulses + tool); livestock vaccination & treatment, where the context permits, during the main farming season.

 critical items out of the response package and the request will be fulfilled based on material availability and needs.
- Quantities contingent upon availability of stock at the time of emergency.
- o All bulky items (S/NFI, WASH) are to be assembled at the final destination to maximize air transport capacity.
- Clusters are encouraged to preposition emergency response kit items at strategic warehouses.
