Planned activities and wayward for the next two weeks:

FFP CTP Project

The FFP funded project is in Konduga LGA in Malari Ward and Konduga Wards. Currently we are targeting households and we are doing a 100% coverage in these areas. The project will target IDPs, Vulnerable host and returnees in Communities of Yandadari Kura, Yandadari Gana, Mandadari 1 & 2, Mashimari Gana, Mashimari Kura, Konduga Main Town and Mandadari Kura IDP camp. As at Dec 21, 2016 we have targeted 4712 households (2516 individuals). We will be using a per capita approach to calculate transfers per individuals and this will be for 5 months (January to May 2017)

LDS CTP Project

The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints (LDS) funded project is in MMC LGA in Bolori ward. The project is implemented in Bolori Kasuwa, Buzu Quarters and Shuwari 3. About 500 households will benefit from 3 months cash transfer between Januarys to March 217.
