## **Lesson Learned – Exploitation / Abuse Exist...**

- We have a big problem;
- Most of the time, they go undocumented and unreported;



# Challenges – Risks of dealing with Exploitation & Abuse of beneficiaries

- As an agency, the biggest problem most times is our staff...few bad eggs can ruin every good work;
  - Instead of trying to get them to be very good on their jobs, support them to become good people, then they can do better job;
- There must be stiff punishment for this kind of inhumane behaviors...termination is my final recommendation...
- Lead by example;
- Use element of Surprises...through segregation of duties/...it ensures accountability; {this might not be good enough}
- People with authority have so much power to spoil your work;
- First thing comes to mind here are community leaders...how about your partners...contractors...etc...;
- They must know your values while working with you;
- They must know that beneficiaries are your clients, they can't mess with your customer base;
- The beneficiary ignorance... very prevalent in Women & Girls in Borno state;
- The more the know the better;
- Explore every avenue to let them know;
- Knowing is as important as receiving assistance;



### **Exploitation & Abuse Prevention Messages**

#### The IRC is your friend!

- The IRC is here to support you regain your life back;
- We'll treat you properly and with respect in all our interactions;
- We will be:
  - Polite:
  - Independent and simple;
  - Sensitive to gender;
  - Fair;
  - Capable;
  - No hidden agenda;
  - No exploitation;
  - We have a responsibly to support you and your community;

#### Watch Out!...

Don't do this to any one [our staff, volunteers or anybody];

- Don't give or accept bribe or favor in order to access assistance;
- Don't let anyone abuse you in order to give you assistance;
- We don't bully, ask for sex or use abusive word in trying to support you. If that happens report to IRC immediately;
- We don't threaten you or behave unethical with children;
- We don't ask for sex in exchange for relief assistance;

If this happens make sure someone in IRC is aware!!!

#### Things to Know-your rights

Those in need of humanitarian assistance have rights, including;

- Right to receive assistance;
- Right to live with dignity;
- Right to be protected from harm;
- Right to get the right information to make good decisions;
- Right to be part of decision-making that may affect your right to complain if things are not done right;

#### COMPLAINTS ...

Stop any IRC staff and inform him/her immediately, it's your right to complaint!!!



# Interesting Findings ...

- Knowledge is power...if they know...they can't be abuse/exploited...;
- Especially women & girls in the first instance feel empowered by the EA prevention messages...;
- If agency don't emphasis this risk...exploitation/abuse is very likely to take place;
- Beneficiary abuse & exploitation is always happening, most times decision makers are not aware it is happening;
- Beneficiaries are very likely not to mention exploitation/abuse because of fear or cultural norms;
- Strong protection mainstreaming targeting women & girls has proven to reduce the risk;
- Community leaders and religious leaders are powerful stakeholders. If they buy the idea, there is high tendency that exploitation/abuse will never occur;



### **Further Learning/Recommendation**

- Despite all the sensitization, acceptance, continuous monitoring is key;
- Effective coordination with key protection sectors/programmes like WPE/Protection has help the IRC reach more women & girls with these prevention/empowerment messages;
- At project startup, Protection team should be consulted especially on women & girls issues and how project could target them without doing harm in the communities;
- Effective communication: programme team should explain to the communities the criteria for targeting, why and what the expectations are associated with this targeting, feedback mechanism;
