# Response Monitoring Framework

## Define the monitoring framework

### Response Plan

- How is the target logframe framed 
- What can I monitor
  - informs the data collection tool
- What falls “outside the response plan(s)”

*Ad hoc* crisis logframe



# Monitoring tools

## Tools available for monitoring

- Target Logframe (from Response Plan and ad hoc crisis)
- Needs (PiN and Severity)
- 5Ws
- FTS (or other tools)
- *Ad hoc* tools (e.g. emergency tracker etc)

# Gap analysis

## Identifying gaps

But what gaps

- Geographic coverage
- Unique people coverage
- Needs coverage
- Partners response capacity mapping (prep)
- Stocks availability (prep)

# Monitoring the targeting approach

## Monitoring the targeting approach

Are FSC partners reaching those most in need / prioritized in the targeting strategy?

E.g.:

- IPC4 HHs or HHs in IPC4 areas
- Women-headed HHs, HHs with disabled members, high dependency ratio
- HHs with malnourished children
- Children referred from CP actors

## How can we monitor the targeting approach?

- Adjusting the 5W
- Ad-hoc tools

# Monitoring cluster funding

## Monitoring cluster funding

FTS

FSC ad-hoc data collection

- Compare 5W activity reporting with FTS financial reporting
- Integrate project funding sheet into regular 5W reporting  
(and compare with FTS)

# Information sharing

## Information sharing

From FSC to:

- Partners & Stakeholders
  - OCHA / Inter-cluster mechanisms
  - gFSC
- 
- Ensure information is aligned with Partners' own reporting – especially CLAs
  - Ensure timely information sharing
  - Ensure changes (and errors) are reported back to previously shared stakeholders

## Information sharing

Telling the story

Sharing data by itself can relay a wrong message.

An accompanying narrative can assist the data to relay the correct message or story ...  
putting the context into perspective.
