1. Operational overview





Cumulative Summary since the 24 February:

- Individuals Reached: 7.43 million people (approx.) have been assisted through either completed or ongoing activities
- **Reporting to cluster**: A total of **40 organisations** have submitted their 5Ws to the Cluster.
- Locations: 24 Oblasts and Kyiv have been reported (Approx.) The highest reached figures were reported in Kharkivska (1.9m), Kyivska (727k), Dnipropetrovska (596k), Poltavska (455k), Zaporizka (434k).
- Livelihood Activities: Five Organisations have reported ongoing/ completed distribution of Emergency Agricultural Inputs. In total 15 Oblasts were covered, with total Reach of: 105k
- Top 3 Activities (approx.): Rapid Response Rations: 4.2m / General Food Distribution: 2.2m / Hot meals: 950k

- **5Ws Deadline**: Every second Tuesday COB (twice a month)
- Next deadline is COB Tuesday 14 June (to info.ukraine@fscluster.org), pipeline plans remain on a weekly basis.
- The 5Ws should capture 'new people reached' therefore please ensure you pay close attention to the new template circulated; in addition to using <u>only the drop-down</u> options for activities and locations.
- Note Beneficiary Counting Guidance- we need to capture NEW beneficiaries to the extent possible.

- The FSLC regularly receives requests for food assistance from government, NGOs and volunteer groups
- In the last month the FSLC has received over 40 requests to address the food needs of an estimated 500,000 people
- To date 3 requests for a total of **12,470** people have been actioned and completed by 3 different partners
- 2 requests for **250,000** people is due to be completed this month.

Process and challenges

REQUEST RECEIVED

Requests are sent via email or phone

•

Requests are often incomplete and further information is needed DUE DILIGENCE

- Contact is made with the requesting organization to confirm entity, context and needs
- Requesting organisations may not have all the data/info needed to plan for a response

MATCHING PARTNER

٠

- Contact is made with implementing partners who are operating in the area
- Lack of planning information / difficult to know if partners have capacity to cover the request

٠

CONTACT WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES

- Local authorities are contacted to determine if they know the requesting organization, if there are needs and whether they have been already addressed
- Lack of contacts for some oblasts / municipalities

FOLLOW UP

- Continued contact with requesting organization and FSLC partners to close the process.
- Partners not responding to requests

Assistance may have already been provided but not reported

Recommendations

• Before submitting a request to the FSLC, requesting organizations should check with the local authorities first to determine the availability of stocks/kits at the local level and local capacities to provide assistance, this could also enable the combination of several requests which are easier to process

FOOD SECURITY & LIVELIHOODS CLUSTER

- When contacting the FSLC, requesting organization should provide as much information as possible including the total number of individuals (not just households), locations, distribution point, type of assistance required
- FSLC partners should provide planning information in the 5W to ensure pipeline visibility and enable the Cluster to identify partners' capacities to meet requests
- Partners should provide feedback for every request sent. If partners can action the request they should inform the FSLC of the tentative distribution date, and when and where the delivery was done
- Partners should include the information on the 5W once distributions have been completed.



- Digitalisation of the request for food assistance process (online/KoBo or via Activity Info)
- Development of detailed SOPs on how to process requests
- Improve gap analysis and partners planning/capacities
- Improve reporting of completed / actioned distributions
