Three options for completing the annual and monthly report








HOMESTEAD GARDENS UPDATE Partner meeting 05/Feb 2024

- Increase household access to high-quality, nutritious food and dietary diversity in a densely populated and stressed refugee setting.
- ➤ Build resilience in food security with complementary nutritious foods and support the health and wellbeing of refugees.
- Provides an opportunities for capacity building
- Increase local vegetable production and availability to address an anticipated annual vegetable deficit during lean season in Cox's Bazar District.
- Continuous changes of the context including food ration cuts.






