

In November 2023, the food security sector assisted around 1.4 million people with food assistance and around 403 thousand people with agriculture and livelihoods, of which 84 percent (1,189,980) and 40 percent (162,806) respectively received support, through cash voucher assistance (CVA). A total of 35 organizations, national, and international non-governmental organizations, and UN agencies used various delivery mechanisms such as direct cash payment, mobile money transfers, paper vouchers, and electronic vouchers. Borno state hosts 74 percent of the CVA beneficiaries, with Yobe state hosting 24 percent and Adamawa state has 1 percent.

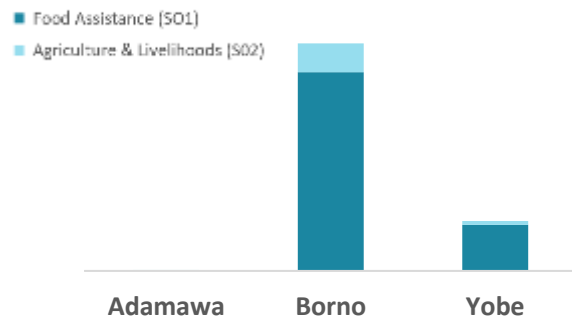

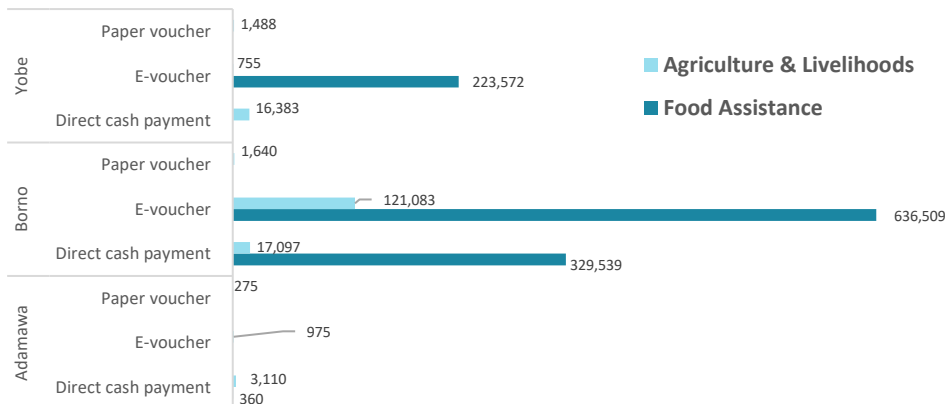

### Cash & Voucher Assistance at State Level

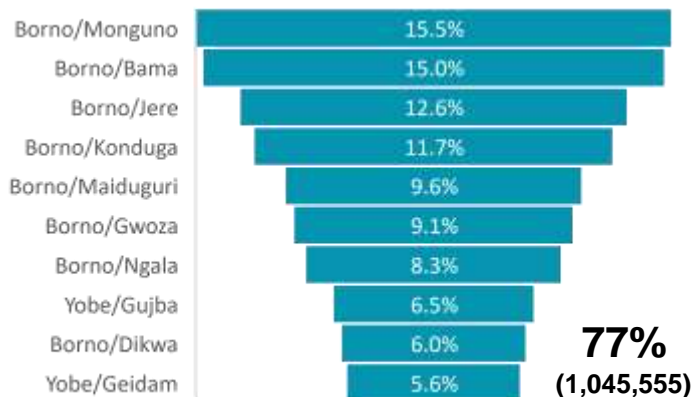
