## **Logistics Efficiencies & Pre-positioning Strategy**




### Logistics Cluster drives efficiencies across the entire South Sudan humanitarian response.



#### **Efficiencies:**

- LC's Goal: Reduce air ops
- LC does not fly to locations reachable by road/river
- Fixed-wing more efficient than Heli
- LC determines dispatch location



#### **Efficiencies:**

- LC's Goal: Increase road ops
- Pre-position during dry season →
   Reduces air ops in rainy season
- Plan Ahead:
  - Early Procurement
  - Get Cargo on the Roads

#### **Efficiencies:**

- LC's Goal: Increase river ops
- Use river to Pre-position year-round
   → Reduces air ops
- Plan Ahead:
  - Just in Time Air Deliveries →
     Pre-positioning
  - Multi-month supply



  - o ex-Bor (Dry Season)
    - Gumuruk-Pibor-Likuangole (1x/month)
    - Jonglei: Duk/Ayod/Uror/Nyirol (1x/month)



# Road Transport—Beyond Responses



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- Medium-Distance Convoys from LC Hubs
- Use IOM CTS Trucks
- Cargo to be pre-positioned in these hubs
- Beyond Wau
  - Locations in Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Warrap,
     Western Bahr el Ghazal
- Beyond Bentiu (dry season)
  - Guit, Mayom, Rubkhona Counties
  - Central Unity (Koch, Leer, Mayendit Counties)
- **Beyond Malakal** (dry season)
  - Locations in Fashoda, Baliet Counties



## **River Transport**






- Dispatch locations: Bor & Malakal
- Barge Routes:
  - Bor→Renk via Malakal & points between
  - Renk→Bor via Malakal & points between
- Boat Routes:
  - Bor→Old Fangak & points between

## What About Storage?






- LC manages Common Storage warehouses for the humanitarian community in 9 hubs.
- Mobile Storage Unit Loans: The Logistics
   Cluster provides MSUs in deep-field
   locations for the strategic prepositioning of
   relief items based on the needs of
   requesting organisations, as part of advance
   preparedness measures.
- → Priority is given to organisations willing to manage MSUs as common storage facilities versus individual use especially in the Inter-Cluster Working Group(ICWG) prioritised areas for interventions

## **Air Transport**





- Air Transport is Last Resort
- Focus of Air Operations:
  - ICWG Priorities (unless reachable by road/river)
  - Rapid Missions
  - Locations unreachable by road/river
- Fleet:
  - Fixed wing: Juba (No helis based in Juba!)
  - Helis: Bor, Rumbek
- Efficiencies in Air Ops
  - LC determines dispatch location
    - Central Unity: Rumbek
    - Jonglei & Upper Nile: Bor or Juba, depending on airstrip
  - Fixed-wing more efficient than helis
  - Airstrip Rehabilitation for fixed-wing
  - LC does NOT fly to: Bentiu, Malakal, Wau


# Logistics Efficiencies —The Numbers



- Logistics Cluster coordinated road convoys to 8 locations in Jonglei, transporting 958 MT of humanitarian cargo during 2019 dry season.
- 958 MT by **Air** = Approx. **\$4.5 million**
- 958 MT by **Road** = Approx. **\$215,000**
- Logistics Cluster transported 662 MT by Road through the Beyond Bentiu & Wau
  Responses in 2019, reaching 45 locations in 4 states (Northern Bahr El Ghazal, Unity,
  Warrap and Western Bahr el Ghazal)
- 662 MT by **Air** = Approx. **\$3 million**
- 662 MT by **Road** = Approx. **\$150,000**
- → We need to capitalize on the roads in Dry Season
- →If we don't, the humanitarian community is misusing donor dollars

### **Action Points**



- Operational Efficiencies Require the Entire Humanitarian Community's Support:
  - Clusters → Spread the word to all partners
  - Donors → Early funding for procurement/pipelines
  - Organisations → Plan ahead, Procure early, Pre-position
