













Response by Modality (Cumulative)



Gu Flood Preparedness - Rains Underway



- ☐ The Gu floods are already underway in different parts of the country
- ☐ Disseminate the FAO SWALIM "Digniin" Gu-flooding Early Warning alert and forecast messages
- BeletWeyne District Heavy rains expected in Beletweyne and surrounding areas in the next 3 days, high likelihood of flash floods & rapid river level rise, residents to take precaution.
- Buale District Heavy rains expected in Buale and surrounding areas in the next 3 days, high likelihood of flash floods & rapid river level rise, residents to take precaution.
- ☐ Garbahharey District Heavy rains expected in Garbahharey and surrounding areas in the next 3 days, high likelihood of flash floods & rapid river level rise, residents to take precaution.
- □ Baidoa District Heavy rains expected in Baidoa and surrounding areas in the next 3 days, high likelihood of flash floods, residents to take precaution.

Gu Flood Preparedness - Cash Coordination



- □ FSC partners should not confuse between FSC Sectoral Cash and Multi Purpose Cash Assistance (MPCA)
- ☐ FSC <u>coordinates all food security and livelihoods assistance regardless of modality. This includes in-kind food assistance, and Cash & Voucher assistance (CVA)</u>
 - Unconditional Cash/ Voucher Assistance with the food MEB transfer value
 - Conditional Cash/ Voucher Assistance (e.g. cash for work, cash for assets etc.)
 - Cash + inputs
- ☐ The Cash Working Group (CWG) is responsible for MPCA coordination
- □ All FSC sectoral cash data should be reported to FSC while all MPCA data should be reported to the Cash Working Group (CWG)
