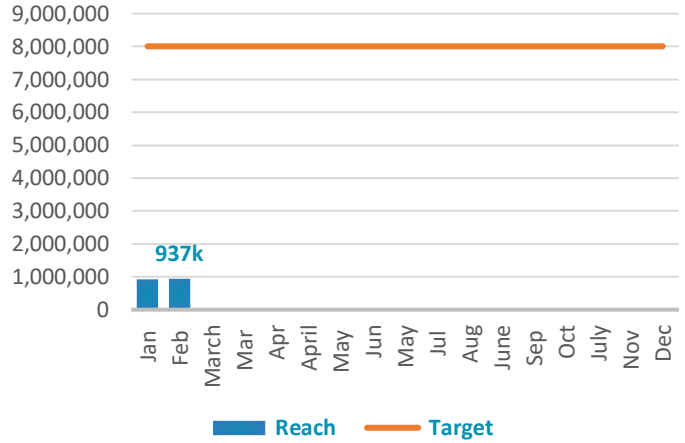

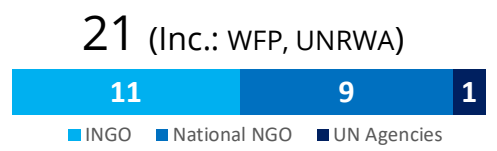

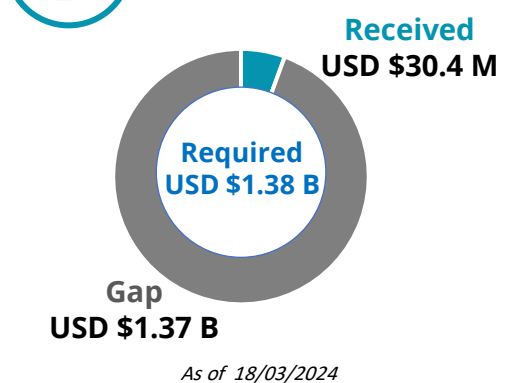

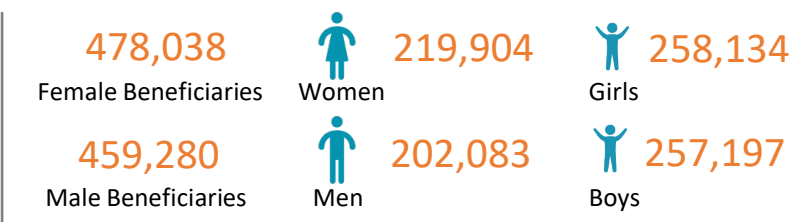

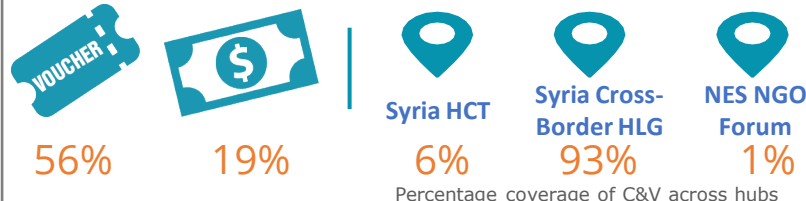
HRP 2024 FUNDING STATUS

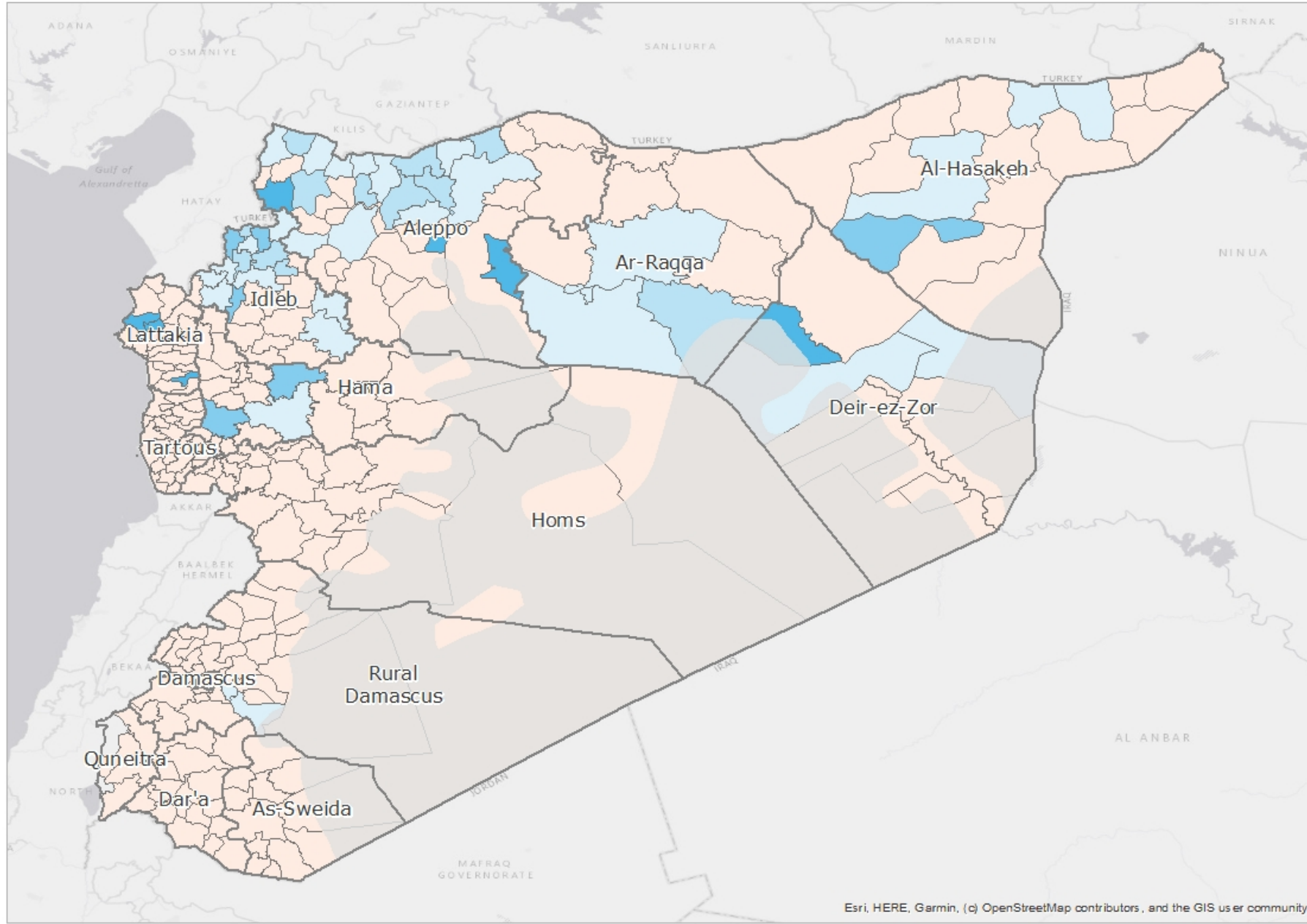


**CASH AND VOUCHER FOOD BASKET SUPPORT

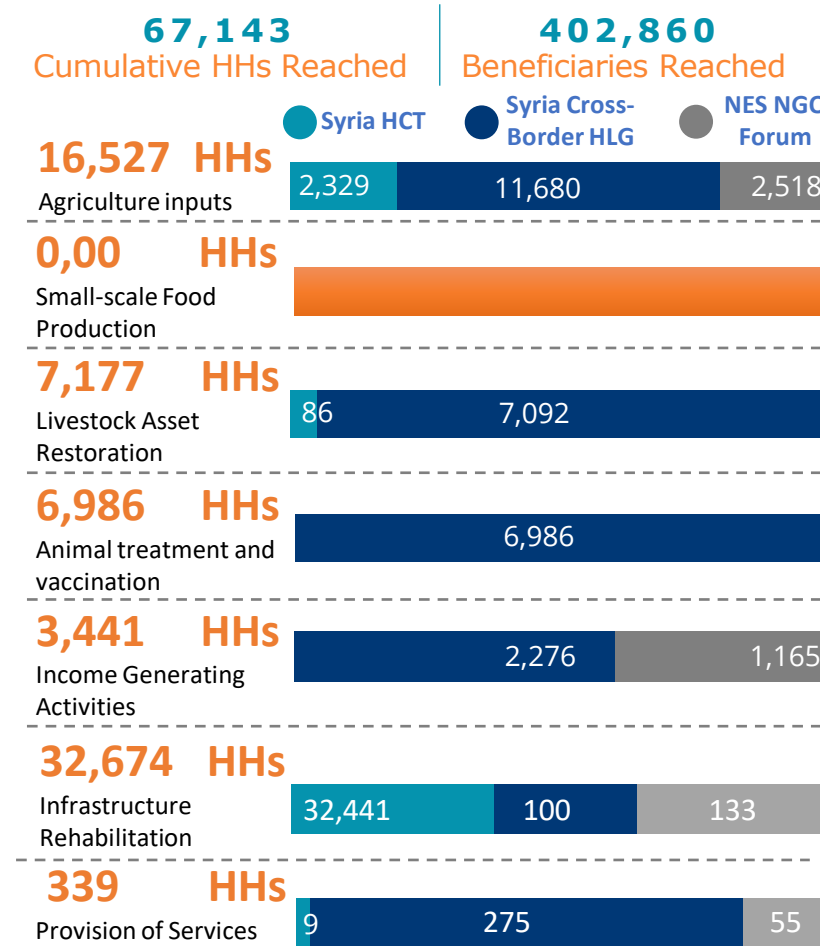
SO 2: Support self-reliance of affected households by protecting and building productive assets and restoring or creating income generating opportunities to save and sustain lives.

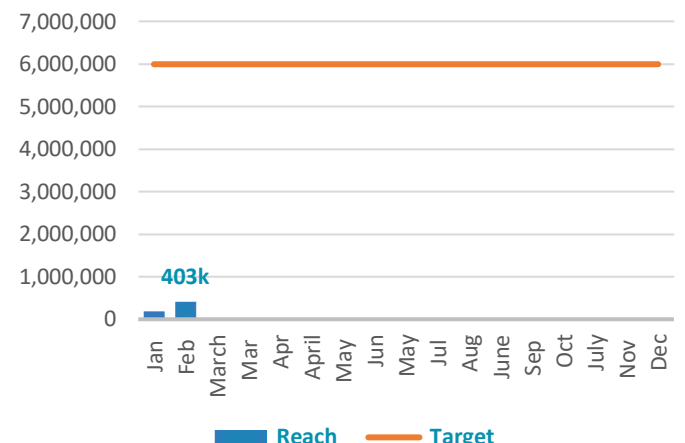

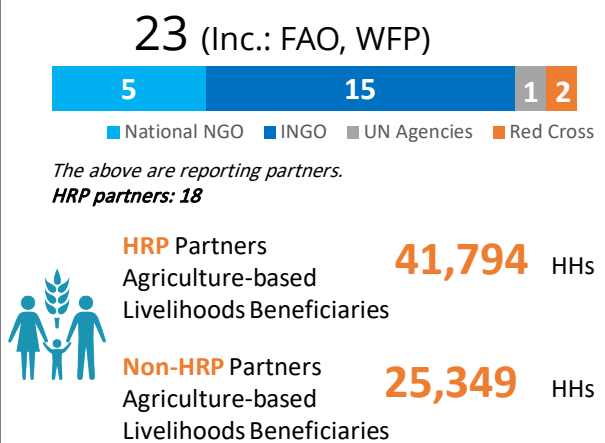
FOOD AND LIVELIHOODS NUMBER OF HOUSEHOLDS REACHED



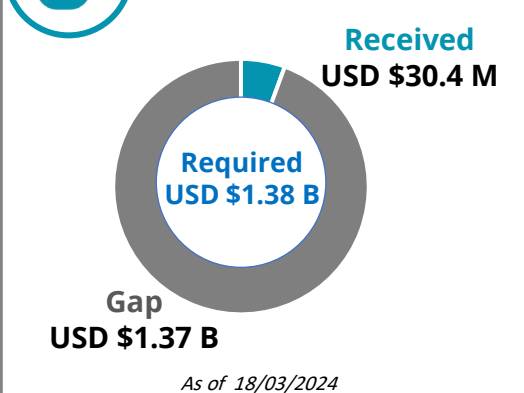

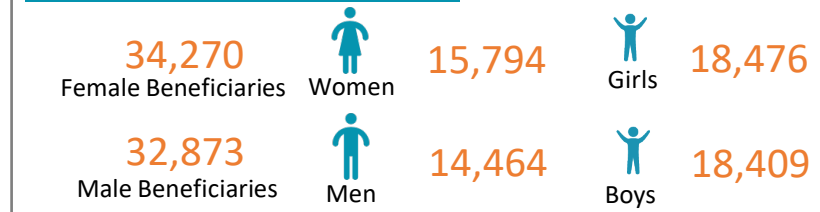
