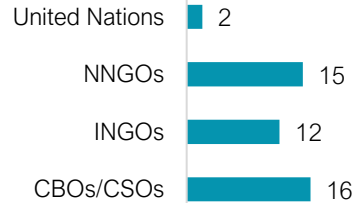

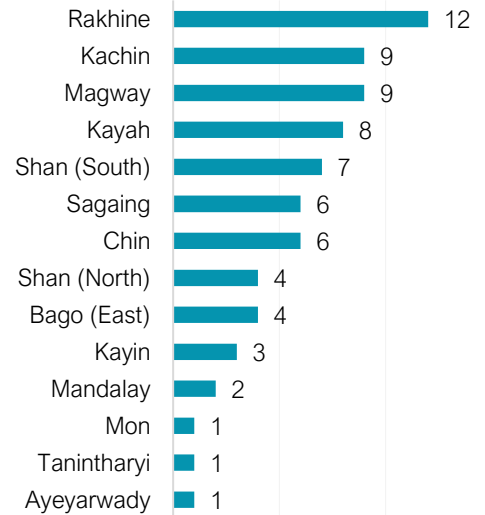

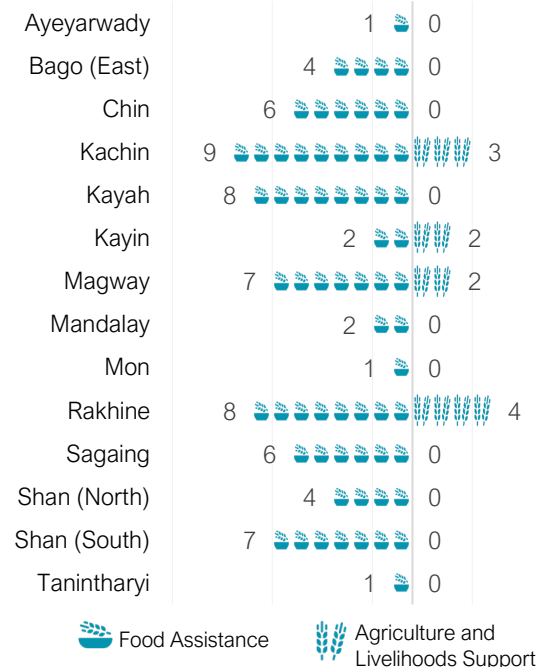
Number of Partners by FSC Main Interventions

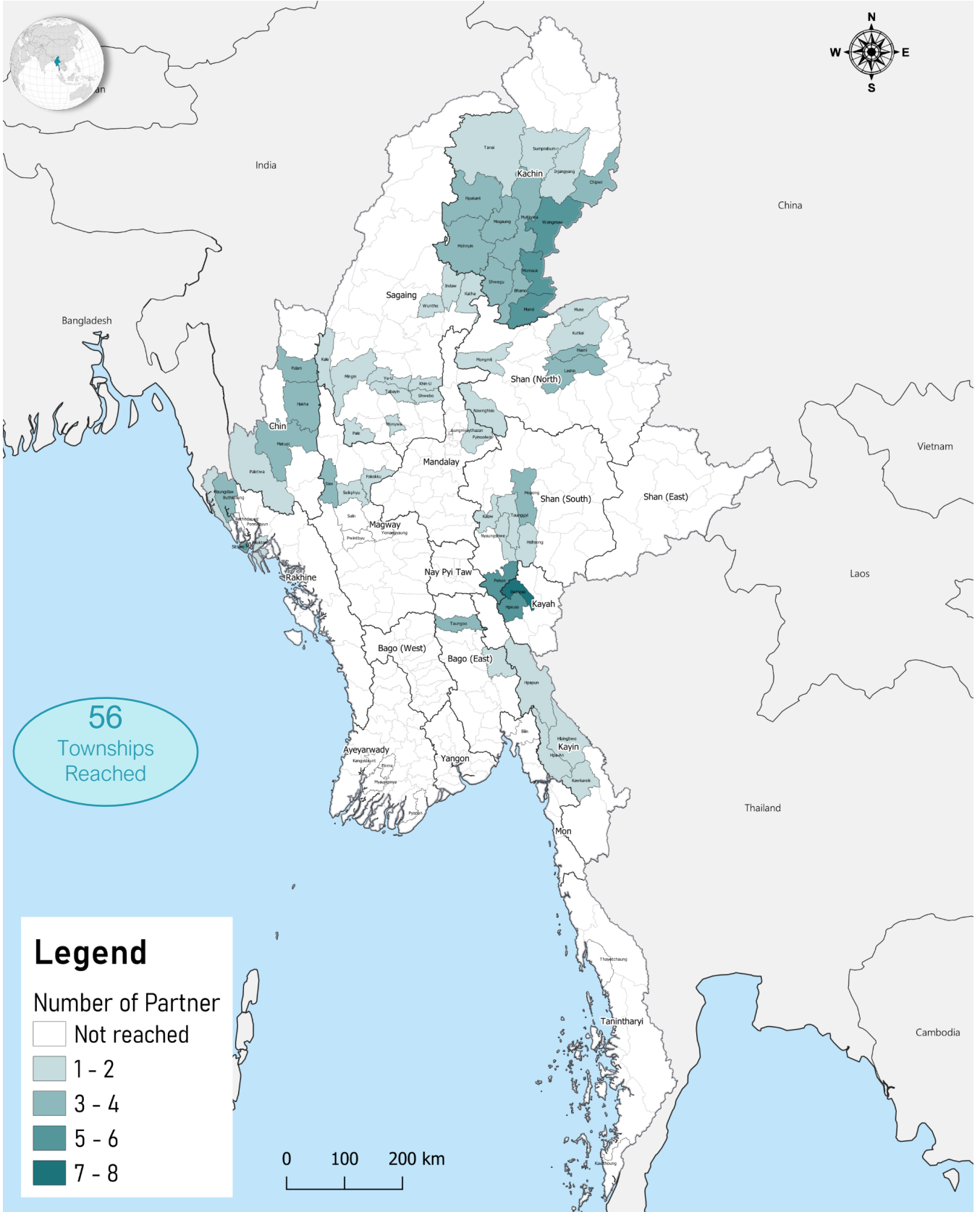

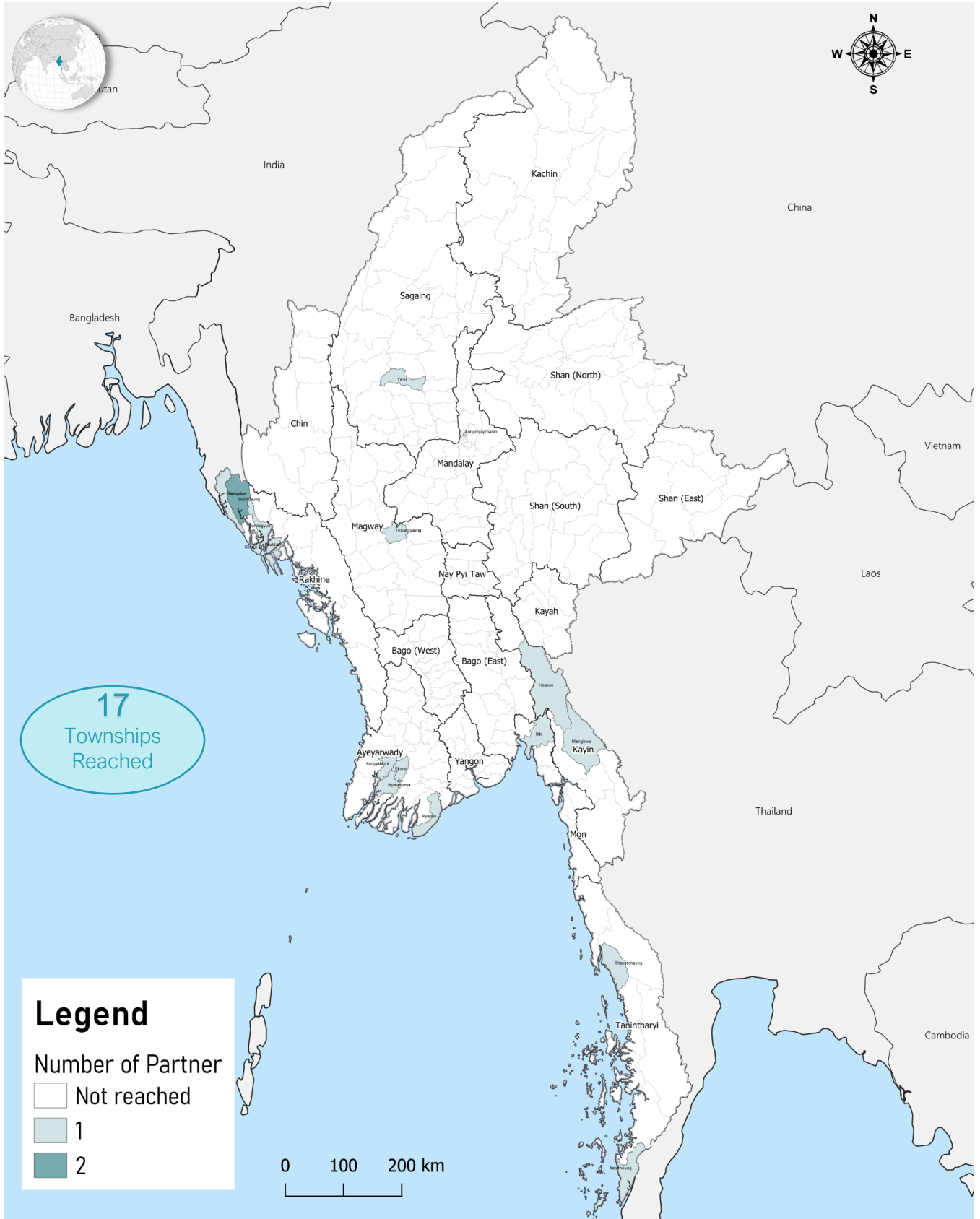

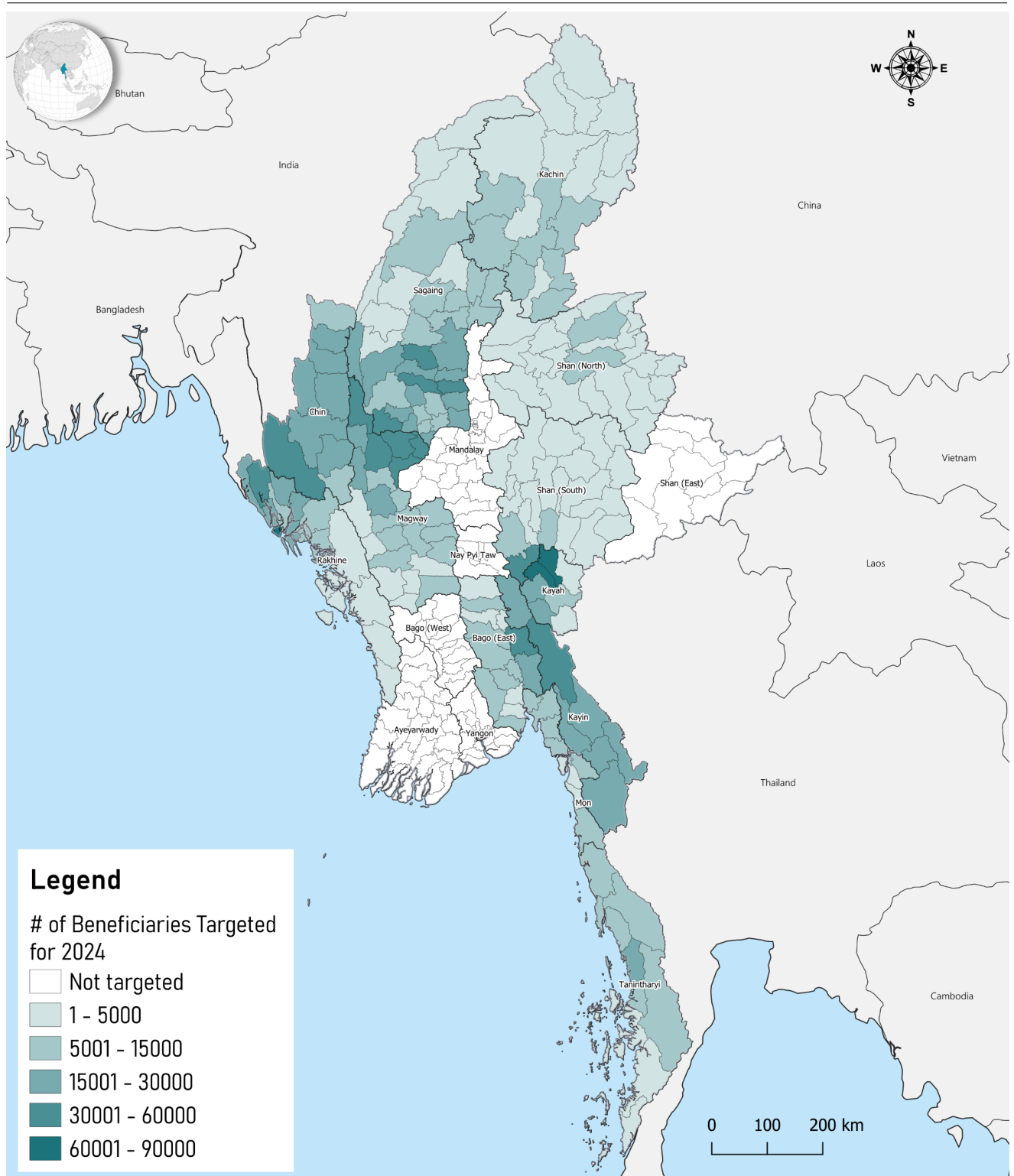

HNRP 2024: FSC Targeted Area Map

January to December 2024

In 2024, the FSC targeted a total of 2.3 million vulnerable and crisis-affected people in 199 townships out of a total of 330 townships in Myanmar. Cluster partners made efforts to provide assistance in hard-to-reach townships. The map below shows the FSC's target by township for 2024.

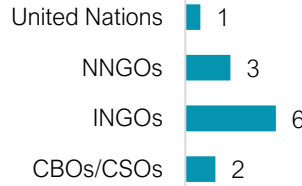

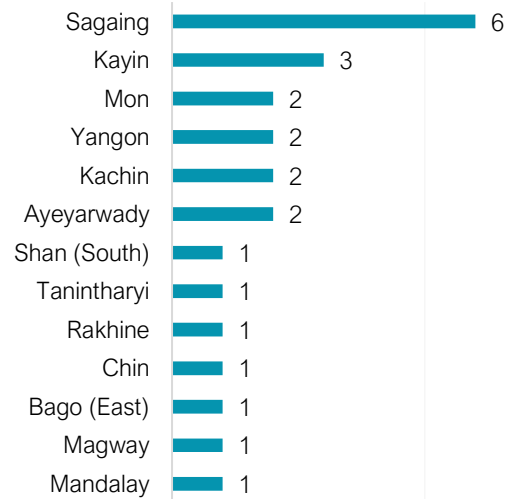
