
## MYANMAR FOOD SECURITY CLUSTER

#### **Highlights**


- Overall, a total of 51 (38%) townships were reached across 10 states/regions out of total 134 townships targeted in 12 states/regions under CO1.
- At Q1/2024, FSC reached 27% of its annual targets for CO1, while achieving 106% of the Q1 targets.
- A total of 5 townships not initially targeted for CO1 were successfully reached.
- However, a significant gap is indicated in areas where conflicts are escalating, including Rakhine, Northwest, and Southeast regions. Efforts are ongoing to reach IDPs and other vulnerable groups in those areas.
- Over 1M targeted beneficiaries were left unmet, while a total of 99K beneficiaries exceeded the targets in 19 townships.






#### **Highlights**


- Overall, only 11 (6%) townships were reached across 6 states/regions out of total 197 townships targeted in 12 states/regions under CO2.
- At Q1/2024, FSC reached 10% of its annual targets for CO2, while achieving 41% of the Q1 targets.
- A total of 6 townships not initially targeted for CO2 were successfully reached.
- 723K targeted beneficiaries were left unmet, while a total of 39K beneficiaries exceeded the targets in 6 townships.



# MYANMAR: FSC CO3 - Life-saving emergency agriculture and livelihoods assistance




#### **Highlights**


- Overall, only 10 (45%) townships were reached across 4 states/regions out of total 173 townships targeted in 12 states/regions under CO3.
- Agriculture kits of staples crops and/or vegetables represent the largest activity followed by FFS and farmer training and cash for work activity.
- 421K targeted beneficiaries were left unmet, while a total of 10K beneficiaries exceeded the targets in 3 townships.
- At Q1/2024, FSC reached 5% of its annual targets for CO3, while achieving 22% of the Q1 targets.
- CO3 (Agriculture & Livelihood) achievement is remarkably low (5%) against annual targets, primarily due to funding limitations for agriculture and livelihoods, as well as other operational challenges such as lack of humanitarian access due to armed conflicts.
