5Ws: update – as of April 12th

Strengthening Humanitarian Response

Cumulative Summary: Since the 24th February

- **Individuals Reached:** **6 million** people (approx.) have been assisted through either completed or ongoing activities
- **Reporting to cluster:** A total of **35 organisations** have submitted their 5Ws to the Cluster.
- **Locations:** **25 Oblasts** have been reported – The highest reached figures were reported in Kharkivska (1.7M approx.), followed by Lvivska (1.2M approx.) and Mykolaivska (523k approx.)

Round Update (06 April – 12 April)

- **Reporting to cluster:** A total of 22 partners provided their updates to the Cluster. We had 5 new partners (report for the first time).

Planned

- **Livelihood Activities:** 3 Organisations have submitted plans with MPC, Emergency Agricultural Inputs, Rehabilitation of Community livelihoods reported. In total 17 Oblasts covered, with an Expected Reach: TBD

- Include activities which are not funded

SUMMARY OF THE DATA

Since the 24th February, a total of 26 organisations have reported their activities (5Ws) to the Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster (FSLC) of Ukraine.

The below summary is cumulative and based on those activities reported as Completed and Ongoing during the period 24th February until the 30th March.

Reporting is currently undertaken through the 5Ws on a weekly basis with submissions provided to the Cluster by Tuesday COB. The cluster compiles the reports and thereafter shares the cleaned figures with OCHA by Wednesday COB. Please note that some organisations may be involved in food security activities but are yet to report to FSLC Ukraine.

PARTNER PRESENCE BY OBLAST

Total number of Partners: 130 (approx)

FSLC partners include donors, lead reporting organizations (10) and implementing partners (110). Currently partners have reported activities in all 25 Oblasts.

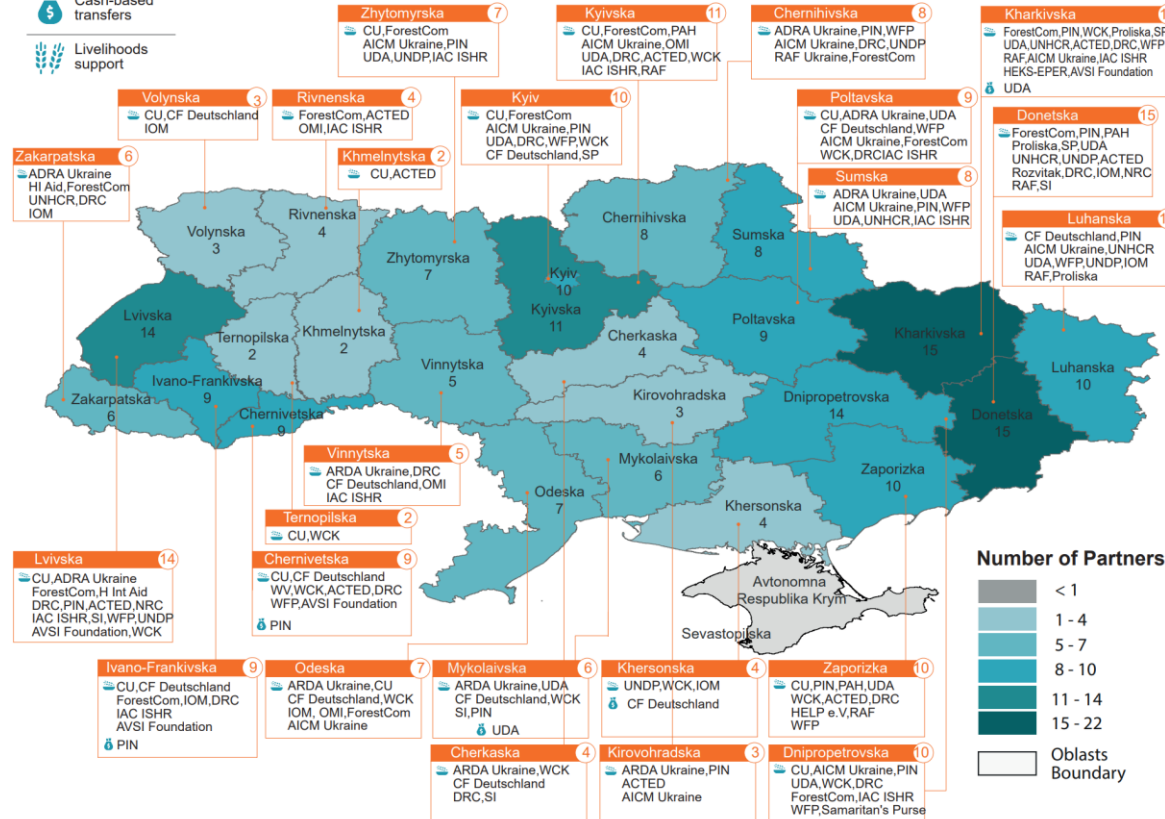
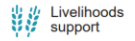
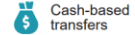
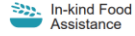

As of 6 April 2022



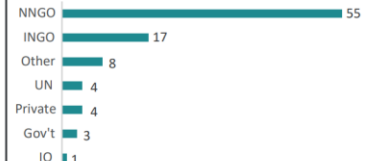
Legend

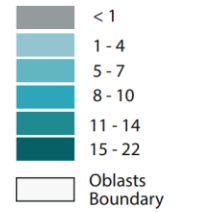

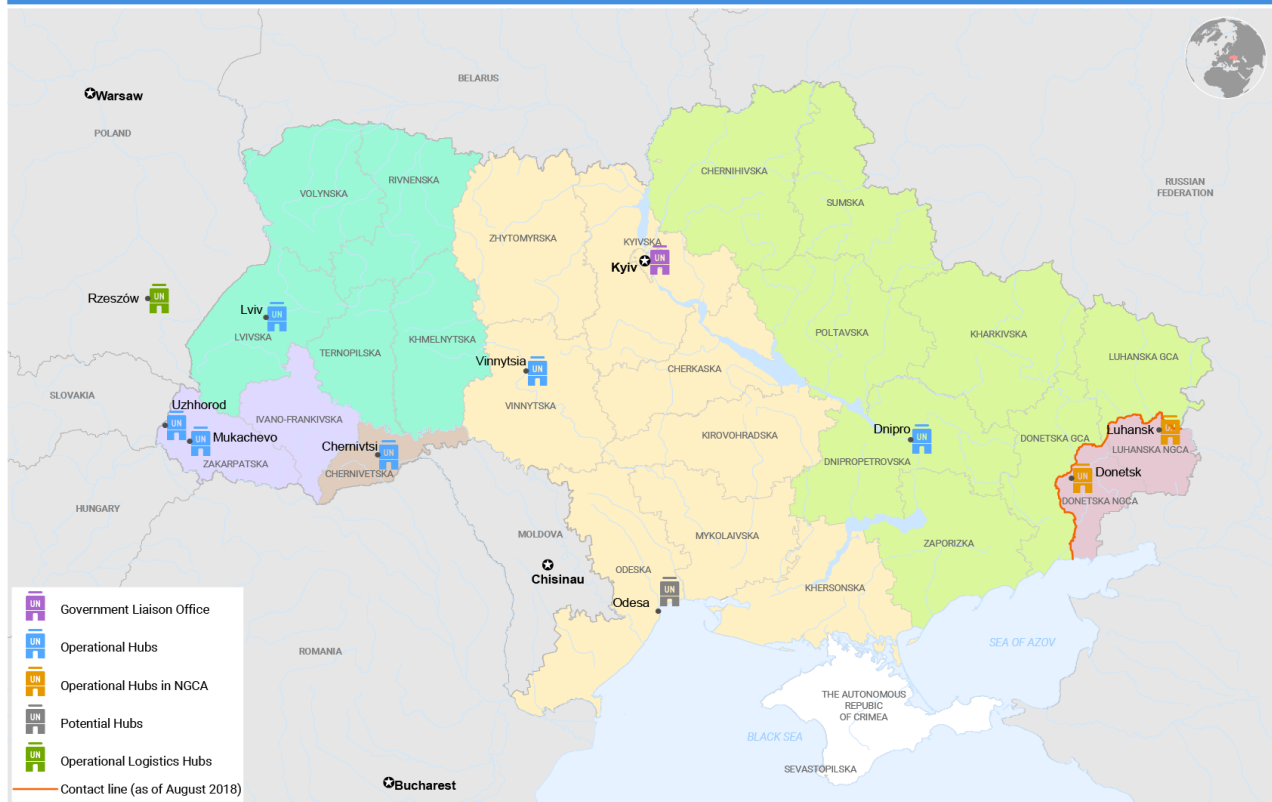
