1. Operational overview



5Ws: update –as of April 26th

UKRAINE FOOD SECURITY & LIVELIHOODS CLUSTER Strengthening Humanitarian Response

Cumulative Summary: Since the 24th February

- Individuals Reached: 3.945 million people (approx.) have been assisted through either completed or ongoing activities
- **Reporting to cluster**: A total of **39 organisations** have submitted their 5Ws to the Cluster.
- Locations: 24 Oblasts have been reported The highest reached figures were reported in Kharkivska (1.1m approx.), followed by Lvivska (374k approx.) and Kyiv (348k approx.), Poltavska (242k approx), Dnipropetrovska (231k approx.).
- Livelihood Activities: 3 Organisations have reported ongoing/ completed distribution of Emergency Agricultural Inputs. In total 10 Oblasts covered, with a Total Reach of: 28,176
- Top 3 Activities: Hot meals: 645k / In Kind Food Distribution: 1.3m / Emergency Food Kits: 1.7m

Round Update (20 April – 26 April)

• **Reporting to cluster:** A total of 11 partners provided their updates to the Cluster.



4. Food Assistance Working Group and Food Requests

- In an effort to respond to the incoming food requests effectively and efficiently, we will establish a timebound, operational 'Food Assistance Working Group' as part of the FSLC.
- This group should include partners who are actively involved in distributing food assistance and planning to continue in this area of response.
- This group will not involve separate reporting (normal 5Ws) but there will be a focused meeting on a weekly basis OR as needed.
- As part of the work of this group, important issues related to the quality and standards of food assistance (commodities, rations sizes, access issues, etc.) will be managed.
