# 5Ws: update – as of May 17<sup>th</sup>

Cumulative Summary: Since the 24<sup>th</sup> February

- **Individuals Reached:** **6 million** people (approx.) have been assisted through either completed or ongoing activities
- **Reporting to cluster:** A total of **39 organisations** have submitted their 5Ws to the Cluster.
- **Locations:** **24 Oblasts and Kyiv** have been reported – The highest reached figures were reported in Kharkivska (1.6m approx.), followed by Poltavvska (507k approx.), Kyiv city (459 approx.), Zaporizka (411 approx), Dnipropetrovska (403k approx.).
- **Livelihood Activities:** 3 Organisations have reported ongoing/ completed distribution of Emergency Agricultural Inputs. In total 15 Oblasts covered, with a Total Reach of: **87k**
- **Top 3 Activities:** [approx.] Hot meals: **834k** / In Kind Food Distribution: **2.58m** / Emergency Food Kits: **2.52m**

Round Update (11 May– 17 May)

- **Reporting to cluster:** A total of 14 partners provided their updates to the Cluster; Including 1 new partner.
