

Working under the supervision and guidance of the Senior Steering Group.


#### **Main functions**

- Support countries and regions owned initiatives and existing mechanisms to facilitate and strengthen the coordination of actors along the HDP Nexus.
  - Technical support to country processes: analytical and programming efforts (COVID-19 framework).
  - Knowledge generation and dissemination.

#### How

- Using internal expertise both in FAO and WFP and external.
- Functional linkages with the gFSC.
- Engaging discussion with WFP and FAO country teams, and EUDs.

### Support coherent analysis in relation to COVID-19



Ongoing country level monitoring and analyses of COVID-19 risks and impact on food security and food systems:

- FAO COVID-19 assessments on food security and rural livelihoods
- WFP real time assessments
- IPC virtual analyses
- o gFSC COVID-19 Working Group

### Global public goods:

- Produce the Mid-year update of the Global Report on Food Crises.
- UNSC regular updates on "monitoring food security in conflict affected countries".

# Support country level programming and reprogramming

**Technical backstopping to** Support to national partners, EUDs, FAO/WFP country teams (e.g. UNSDCFs process).

- Reprogramming in relation to COVID-19.
- **Programmatic integration** and HDP nexus implementation by area-based coordination and collective accountability mechanism (e.g. Chad).
- Definition of **Collective Outcomes** on Food Security and Nutrition.
- Developing and strengthening Joint Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability and Learning (MEAL) Frameworks.
- Developing of **HDP programming options** and related documentation of **best practices.**

- TSU in collaboration with FAO and WFP programming teams, gFSC and FAO, WFP COs and FSC at country level.
- Perimeter: GRFC food crisis countries (55).
- Based on countries' demand and needs.

# Country diagnosis to support programming Knowledge public goods

#### Country profiles:

Provide the initial basis for *Global Network* support by identifying existing country-level actors and initiatives relevant to the Global Network's dimensions.

#### Financial allocations analysis:

Provide an analysis of country level external financial flows and domestic investments to support resource allocations decisions and enhance coordination and advocacy along the HDP nexus.

### • Policy measures, programming options, and COVID-19 implications:

Provide an analysis of policy measures and COVID-19 implications on food security and food systems with a focus on HDP related policy and programming issues, with the ultimate goal to provide governments and partners with an integrated and effective set of policy and programme responses.

## Knowledge public goods: Country Profiles

• Overview of country-level initiatives and actors working on HDP nexus implementation and relevant to the Global Network dimensions.

#### • Objective:

provide recommendations on how the GN can support the identified initiatives and frameworks. • Focus on 10 countries for 2020 (Afghanistan, Chad, DRC, Haiti, South Sudan, Yemen, Myanmar, Somalia, Mali, + 1 country to be defined).

#### Process and actors:

- Initial desk review GN TSU.
- FAO and WFP COs and FSC to review and validate.
- Coordination with EUDs for EU relevant inputs.
- Identification of key priorities for GN engagement.

### Knowledge public goods: Financial allocations

#### **GLOBAL ANALYSIS**

- **Overview of external financial flows** to the food security, agriculture and nutrition sectors.
- GRFC 2020 food crisis countries (55 food crisis countries).

#### **IN-DEPTH COUNTRY ANALYSIS**

- Humanitarian and development assistance, and government budget, mapped geographically where data is available (e.g. sub-national level).
- FAO and WFP **Response** (beneficiaries vs target population).
- **10 food crisis countries** (Afghanistan, DRC, Chad, South Sudan, Somalia, Haiti, Yemen, Mali, +2 additional countries to be defined).

#### Process and actors:

- Development Initiatives to provide OECD DAC data on ODA and FTS/gFSC data on response.
- TSU to coordinate initial analysis.
- FAO and WFP COs and FSC to review and validate.

# Knowledge public goods: countries' COVID-19 policy response

- Analysis of the policy measures and programming response to the pandemic with a focus on HDP issues.
- A cross-country analysis on the effects and immediate policy responses by governments and partners.
- Long term/structural implications for the agrifood systems.

- **TSU** with **FIRST** team (HQ and countries offices).
- National Consultants per target country.
- FAO/WFP COs and FSC to facilitate coordination of stakeholders inputs.
- 20 countries (Chad, Ethiopia, Burkina Faso, Kenya, Myanmar, Niger, WBGS, Afghanistan, CAR, DRC, Haiti, South Sudan, Sudan, Syria, Zimbabwe, Bangladesh, Iraq, Mali, Nigeria, Venezuela).

## Going Beyond Food and Integration of other actors

Increase collaboration and coordination between agencies and institutions to holistically address the multiple facets of food crises.

- Support the development of multisectoral interventions;
- Programmatic linkages with Peace
   Actors
- Strengthen institutional collaborations with relevant clusters/sectors (e.g. WASH and Health).



# Knowledge generation and dissemination Global public goods

**Country, regional and global analyses** on major drivers of food crises to be presented in global fora, regional meetings and inform national processes.

**Produce knowledge** based on **meta analyses** of existing efforts in relation to COVID-19:

- Conflicts and instability.
- Anticipatory actions.
- Nutrition.
- Social Protection.
- Collecting data under COVID-19 related constraints.

• **TSU** in collaboration with **FAO** and **WFP** specialized units, **gFSC**, country offices, research institutions, think tanks and consultancies.
