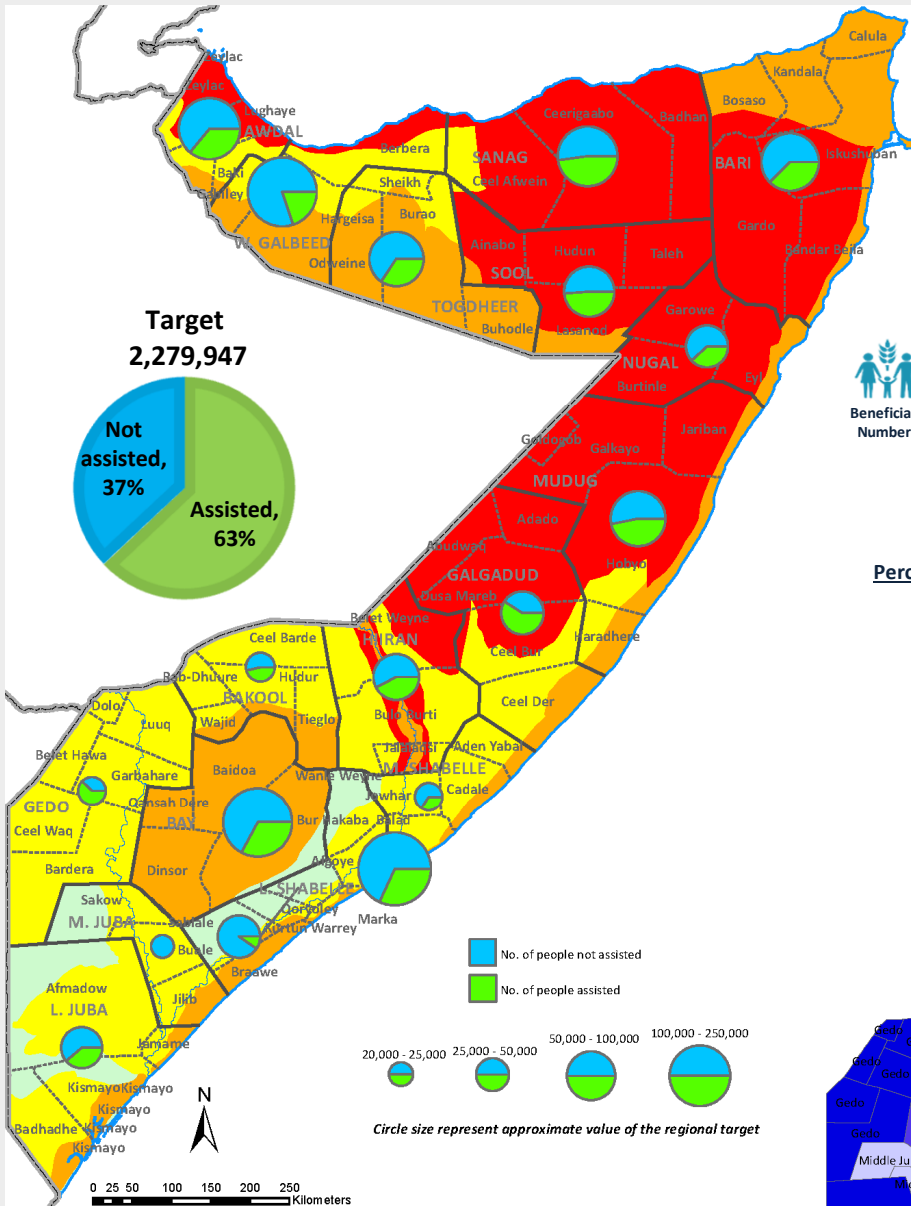


Number of targeted beneficiaries assisted by region

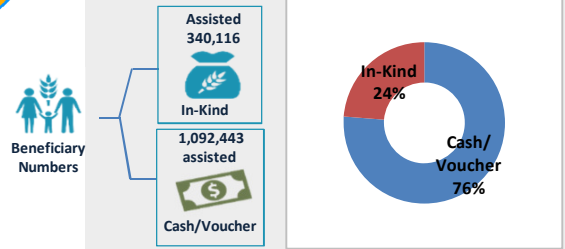

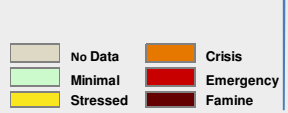
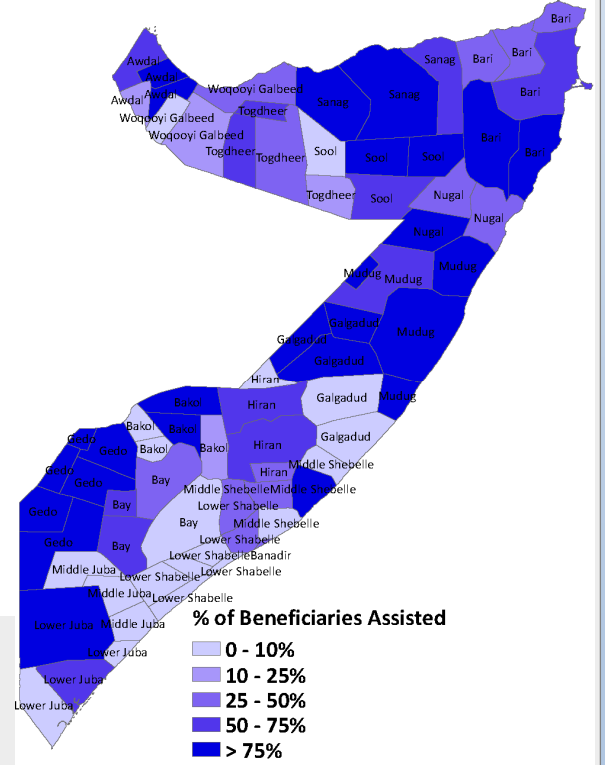

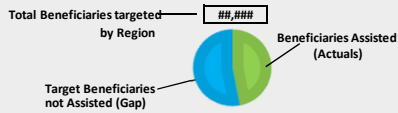


Beneficiary Numbers

FSC partners assisted 1,432,559 (63%) of the targeted population. This represents 10% increase in comparison to the previous month. However, there are gaps in some regions where less than 50% of targeted populations were reached. These areas include parts of Lower Juba, Middle Juba (due to insecurity) parts of Bay, Lower Shabelle and Galgaduud. There is a need to scale up responses given the surge in the number of people in IPC 3 and above. Without humanitarian assistance, the people-facing crisis and emergency food insecurity (IPC 3 and 4) will continue to experience huge food consumption gaps that often result in households engaging in irreversible coping strategies.
