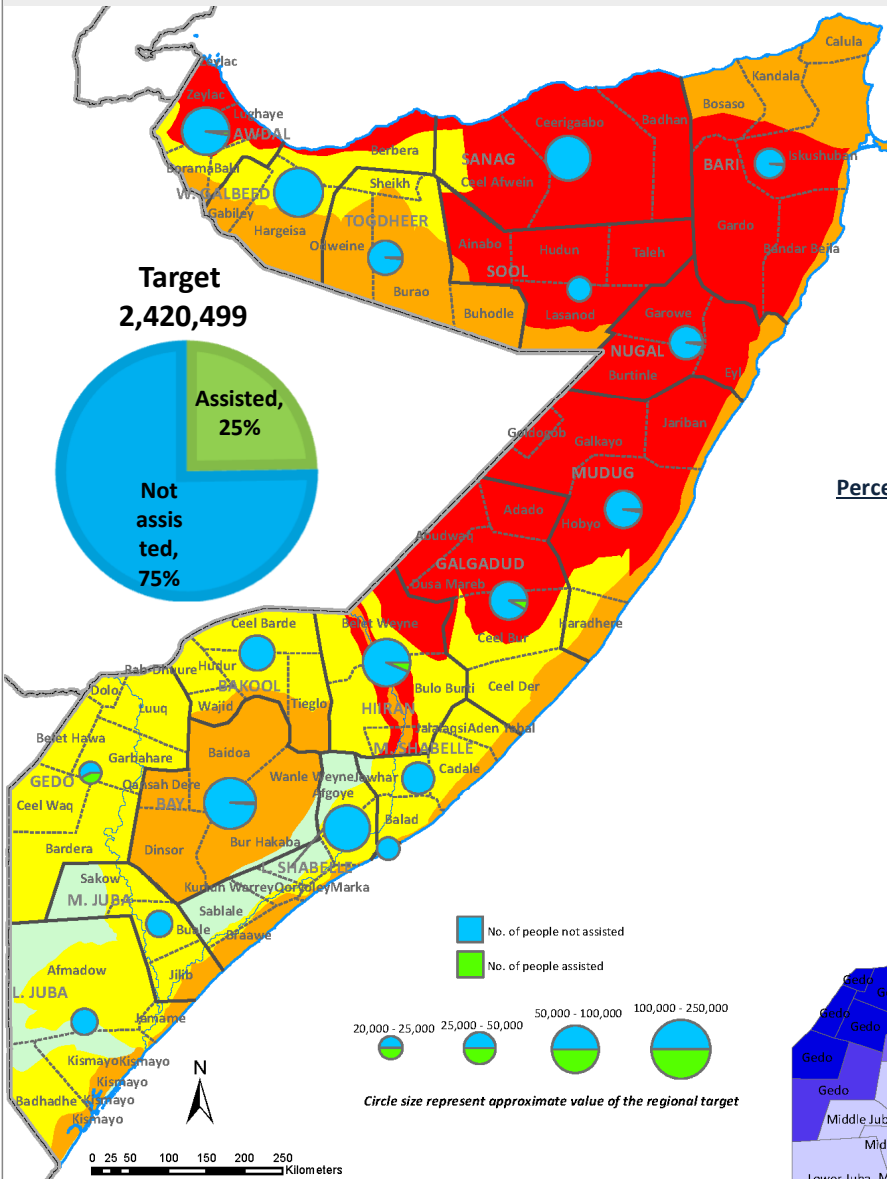


Number of targeted beneficiaries assisted by region



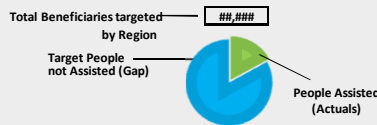
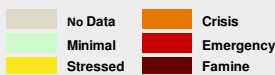
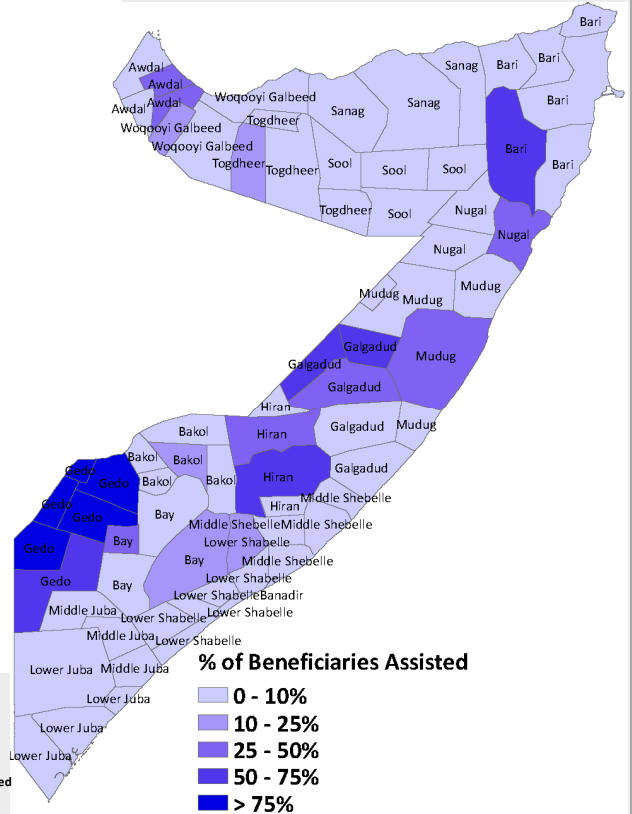

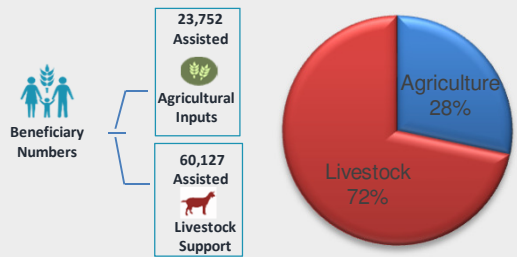
Strategic Objective 2 Update

In June, the FSC partners assisted 83,879 beneficiaries with seasonal inputs interventions. Cumulatively, for the 2019 GU season, 593,049 people were reached, representing 25% of target beneficiaries. As the seasonal cumulative assistance is low (25% coverage in five months), the cluster is urging partners to scale up responses in both agriculture and livestock. The support for livestock assets protection is urgently needed to keep livestock alive and increase milk, meat production and income.
