## Update results

### Result 1 (risk monitoring framework)

- 1) R1 WG indicators and analysis framework: **Shared with JMF Pilot**
- 2) Design information management and risk monitoring system: Country Tracker **Drafted; In-Country Version Drafted – customized for each country**

- 3) Consolidation of available frameworks, reports, data for COVID-19 and Acute Food Insecurity: **On-going – to be updated for July**
- 4) Develop detailed guidance for analyzing/monitoring: **Shared with JMF Pilot**
- 5) Share guidance document and indicators with select clusters: **Shared with JMF pilot**
- 6) Identify countries for feedback and soft launch of JMF: **Completed**
- 7) Develop JMF PPT/Webinar for Pilot: **Completed**
- 8) Translation of JMF Matrix to French – **Completed**
- 9) Improved/clearer connection with key analysis processes

## Result 2 (SOP development, documentation of good practices)

### **Urban WG**

## Result 4 (joint strategy)

- There has been some gaps in interest
- For the next meeting, the R4 lead should identify some good examples – at least 2 - from various countries. These examples can help the R4 to populate the matrix

## Result 5 (researches)

**Research areas 1:** This piece of research started July 20<sup>th</sup> with mapping of key agribusiness companies against key commodities and focus countries

**Research areas 2:** This being done through 12 country case studies and commodity research

**Research areas 3:** This research piece about 60% done

- Baselines work for all 12 countries complete
- Now working on key imported commodities which make up food basket/drive food security
- Using data sets being published each week
- Work on commodity areas started on 20<sup>th</sup> July
