

## FSL Cluster Ukraine: Food Security and Livelihood updates

Reporting Period: 24 February – 05 April (inclusive)

Draft of 08 April, 2022

### SUMMARY OF THE DATA

Since the 24<sup>th</sup> February, a total of 29 organisations have reported their activities (5Ws) to the Food Security and Livelihoods Cluster (FSLC) of Ukraine.

The below summary is cumulative and based on those activities reported as Completed and Ongoing during the period: 30<sup>th</sup> March – 5<sup>th</sup> April

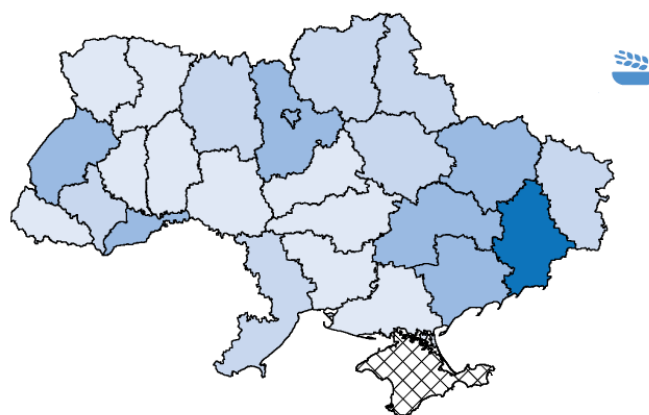
**Reporting** is currently undertaken through the 5Ws on a weekly basis with submissions provided to the Cluster by Tuesday COB. The cluster compiles the reports and thereafter shares the cleaned figures with OCHA by Wednesday COB. Please note that some organisations may be involved in food security activities but are yet to report to FSLC Ukraine.

### PARTNER PRESENCE BY OBLAST

1 Note on terminology

Lead Organization = organization who receives funding from a donor (institutional or private donor) for a given project / programme. The organization can either implement the project directly through its own staff or delegate implementation in the field (totally or partially) to another organization (so called “implementing partner”). The Lead Organisation is also the reporting partner for the FSC, i.e., the one that provides inputs into the 5W.

Implementing partner = organization who receives funding from another organization (so called “lead organization”) for field implementation of a given project (or part of it).
