General Food Assistance | Ration Cuts Overview

During the Ad hoc coordination meeting, FSS reminder the partners about upcoming General Food Assistance ration cuts food voucher value from \$10 to \$8 per person per month, which will be implemented by the WFP general food assistance team implementing partners at refugee camp starting from June 1st.

Cyclone MOCHA Situation update

FSS briefly discussed the cyclone MOCHA response during the coordination meeting. On May 14, around 3:00PM, Cyclone MOCHA hit the coastal areas along the Bangladesh and Myanmar border, Total 429,377 Bangladeshi nationals affected in Cox's Bazar, Chattogram, Noakhali and Feni and destroyed or damaged 36,907 individuals shelter by the cyclone MOCHA and all 33 camps were significantly affected, especially in Teknaf Upazilas.

Cyclone MOCHA FSS partners Response Status

WFP: WFP and implementing partners led emergency rapid food assistance

- WFP's implementing partners reached 8494 individuals' beneficiaries at Cox's Bazar and 5589 individual beneficiaries at Bashan Char respectively by providing rapid response support. Total 11,819 (6230 and 5589 Cox's Bazar and Bashan char) individual beneficiaries received Fortified biscuit, total fortified biscuit packet was 79067 (62,300 in Cox's Bazar and 16,767 in Bashan char respectively). Total 11,531 hot meals (Lunch: 6812, Dinner 4719) were distributed to the Cox's Bazar Cyclone MOCHA affected beneficiaries.
- **BRAC:** Total 2000 dry food packages distributed and 600 hot meals (500g Khichuri (hotchpotch of Rice and lentil, Double eggs curry) distributed in Jaliapalong union of Ukhiya and Samlapur Union of Teknaf through UNO.
- **BCDRS and IFRC (Dry Foods):** 1,800 dry food packages to the Cyclone MOCHA affected community at host and Rohingya community.
- **Mukti:** Mukti reached total 2500 Household, Each household received flatten rice=1kg, Molasses:.5Kg, liquid milk:1 packet (20ml), Candle - 2 pcs, match box-1 box.
- **SHUSHILAN:** 300 dry food packets to sahaporir dip HHS and 500 packet to saint Martine on 17 May 2023. Package consists of: flatten rice 3 kg, molasses.5 kg, nutty biscuits 2 packet, watter bottle 2 lt.
- **Plan International:** Plan International: 1000 Number of Hot meal /ready foods with 1000 bottles (1 litter) drinking
- **YPSA:** 720 HHs reached with dry food packages Shahpari Island area of Teknaf

FSS Sector Preliminary Assessment Report:

During the meeting FSS discussed on the requirement of HH level data to uphold the Humanitarian principal, Accountability to Affected population and the cluster led assessment protocol.
