FSS GENERAL UPDATES

During the FSS monthly coordination meeting, FSS briefly discussed and shared below general update.

- WFP has increased the transfer value of the food basket to US\$12.50 for 2024.
- WFP will increase the e-voucher from US\$8 that was set in June to US\$10 starting January.

FSS FIRE RESPONSE 2024 UPDATE

Damages:

- > 842 shelters damaged.
- > 749 shelters destroyed and 93 partially damaged.
- > 33 communal facilities (health, learning centers, mosques, mobile firefighting unit hub
- 63 solar streetlights damaged.
- No casualties reported.

Response:

- FSS partners involved in the fire response: WFP (CODEC & WVI), AMAN, Janoseba Kendro (accountable to CiC).
- As of 15/Jan a total 48,275 cooked meals were provided to affected refugees, of which lunch 24,830 and dinner 23,445.
- > It will take 30-45 days to fully complete the construction of new modelled shelters.
- WFP is continuing the hot meals as some self-relocated refugees with access to kitchen will receive e-vouchers starting 17/Jan. The need of hot meals requirements will decrease over the weeks as construction progresses.

PARTNERS' UPDATES

HELVETAS

HELVETAS is implementing SHINE project by the partner of PROTTYASHI and UTTARAN in Ukhiya and Teknaf upazila. In a winter season agriculture input distributed total 22,000 HH in the camp and 5,500 HH in a host community. Beside that Homestead Gardening 2nd round training conducted by field staff to 152 beneficiary of host community among them 143 beneficiaries were female, and 09 beneficiary were male. Training facilitated by respective LSPs of host community linkage with DAE.

A number of 8 nurseries (4 in ukhiya and 4 in Teknaf) are established. Farmers produce 6 collection and sales centers.

As usual IGA beneficiary, Integrated Demo, Bamboo plantation, Commercial Farmer, School program activities are ongoing in the field.

World Food Program (WFP)

The World Food Program (WFP) previously managed 24 Aggregation Centers. Various organizations, including UNHCR, have handed over their Centers to WFP that is now overseeing 62 Aggregation Centers at the present moment. The Centers in the Upazilas of Teknaf and Ukhiya assist vulnerable host community on-farm beneficiaries with market linkage. WFP intends to open these Centers to all organization in the next months. More information will be provided in the next meeting.
