

# Afar Region : Agriculture Cluster Response Dashboard

January - November 2023

Agriculture partners in Afar continue to scale up their response. However, resources and low partners presence remain to be a major problem and priority to address all targeted population in the region. Conflict, flood and drought have had a devastating impact on the farming and pastoralist populations in the area, resulting in livestock deaths, a lack of milk production, loss of income, and crop failure. In 2023, DRM-ATF targeted 202,922 people who needed emergency agriculture and livelihoods assistance. As of November 30, 2023 the DRM-ATF cluster partners reached 161,030 people through various interventions.

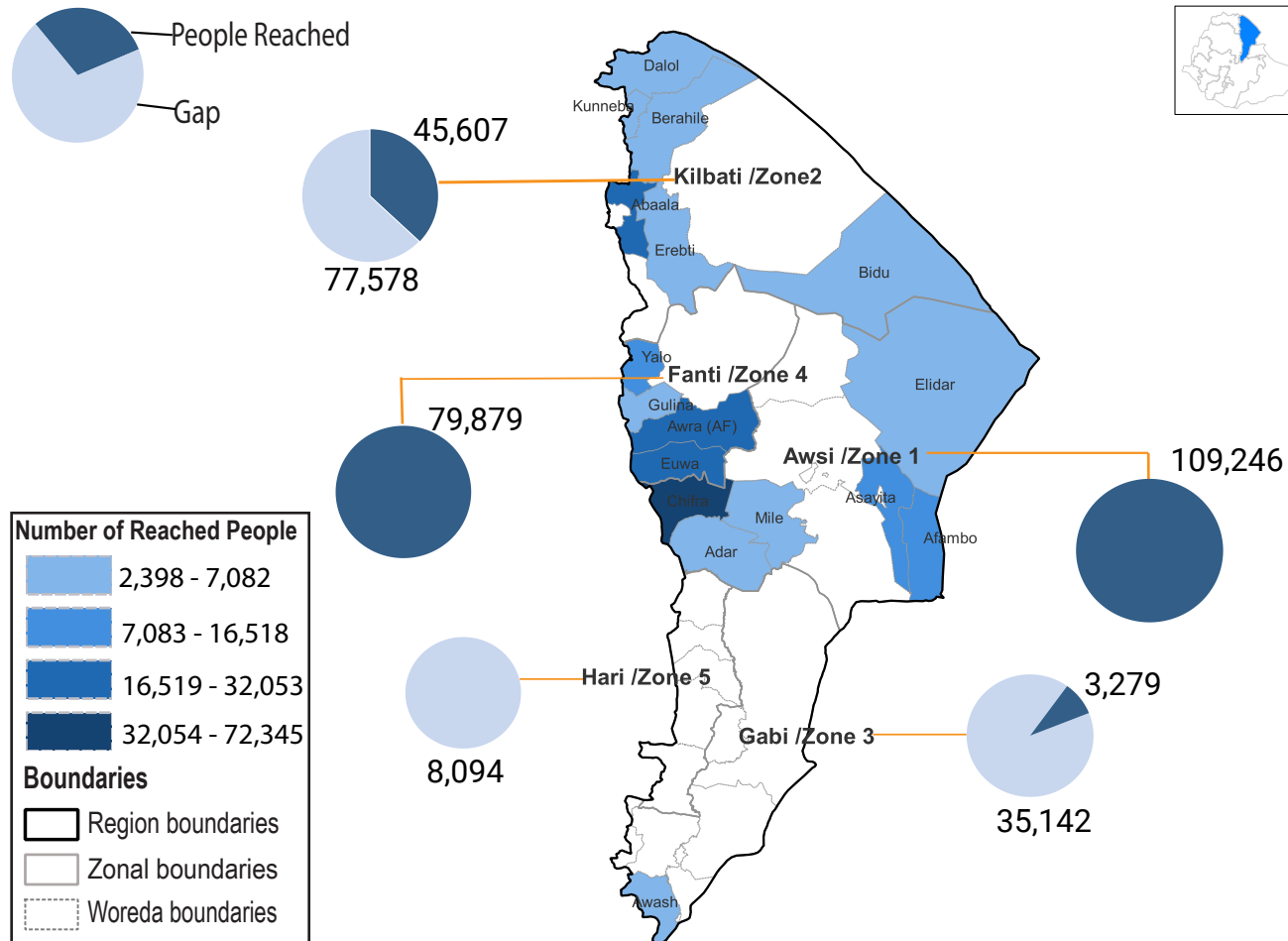

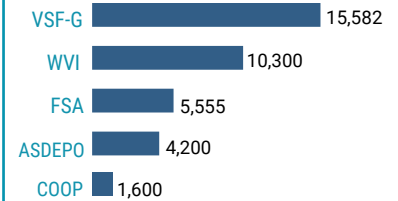

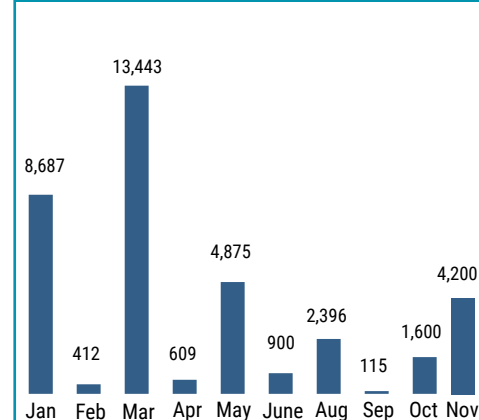

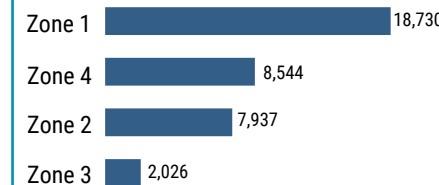
