Agenda	Key discussion point/issues
MOHADM - General Humanitarian Situation Of Puntland	<p>On April 30, 2024 – Vice Minister of the ministry of Humanitarian affairs and Disaster management (MoHADM) of Puntland HE. Ahmed Said (Qoloombi) along with Director- General Mr. Ahmed Nahar Said and other department directors and Head of sections of the Ministry organized Puntland coordination meeting at the Ministry Premises to discuss the humanitarian situation in Puntland and to coordinate the responses of the humanitarian actors in the state. Puntland has been grappling with various challenges, including food insecurity, displacement, and limited access to basic services. The situation is further complicated by the recent Acute Watery Diarrhea/cholera outbreak in several locations of Puntland. According to WHO, the outbreak is driven by high levels of malnutrition among children, insufficient access to clean water, open defecation practices, latrines with poor hygiene and inadequate sanitation among communities, among other factors. Other contributing factors include extreme weather conditions such as drought and flooding, as well</p>



	<p>as conflict and movement of people which have led to a spillover of infections from some neighbouring countries.</p> <p>The Gu rains - which started in mid-Late April – are expected to trigger outbreaks in areas where the disease has not been observed in years. According to the Puntland Department of Early Warning, the rainfall is expected to be above average and may result in localized flooding, especially in low-lying areas and flood prone towns including Qardho, Garowe, Kalkacyo, Jalam and Burtinle and others.</p>
Care -30 April 2024 2024 FSC Achievement	<p>8470HHs for Unconditional cash transfer will be implemented over the next three months for 8 Districts within three Regions as Mudug, Sool and Sanaag and each person will earn 70USD in Sanaag and Mudug Regions and Sool for 90 USD per month</p> <p>Locations are Jariban, North Galkacyo, Galdogob and Saaxo of Mudug Region and will cover 4070HHs in three months of UCT activities and 1700HHs of Badhan and Lasqoray of Sanaag Region as well as 2700HHs Lascanood, Xudun and Taleex of Sool Region</p>
WVI – 30 April 2024 FSC Achievements	<p>Provided cash & Voucher assistance to 7490 rural beneficiaries in Eyl and Dangorayo in the month of April</p>
Norwegian Church Aid – 30 April 2024 FSC Achievements	<p>180 smallholder farmers trained on post-harvest loss management training. Roox village under Galkacyo, Shimbiralle and Canayaskax in Garowe District</p>
SRCS – 30 April 2024 FSC Achievements	<p>SRCS has provided two cash modalities: conditional cash voucher and Unconditional in both Bari and Nugal Region the total are 1175HH: i) 350 HH was cash for nutrition in Waciye and Rako villages; each HH will receive \$120 per month with 4-month instalments; ii) 350HH of multipurpose cash assistance provided in Qardho, number of instalments, and transfer value are the same as above. iii) 475 HH of multipurpose cash assistance is provided in Sinjiif, Qarhis, and Hasbahalle under Garowe and Eyl Districts. Each HH will receive \$110 per month in four-month instalments. - in April SRCS distributed seeds to Iskushuban farmers 88HH.</p>
Puntland Development Organization – 30 April 2024 FSC Achievement	<p>PDO conducted food distribution for WFP Relief Project in Gardo, Bari region, reaching a total of 1800 HHs with life-saving and hunger-minimising assistance.</p>
SCI_ April 30 2024 FSC Achievement	<p>The Puntland Area Office of SCI provided cash transfer to: i) 435 HHs in Bari region (90 USD per HH); ii) 412 HHs in Nugal region (80 USD per HH); iii) 14,151 HHs of pregnancy and lactating women in Jariban district. Furthermore, SCI is conducting rapid assessments for Sool region.</p>





